

Memorandum Some Time in the middle of August I arrived
 at St. Thomas where meeting with Samuell Bradley Capt. Kidd's
 Brother-in-law, and after being some time there the Governour
 knowing I came from those parts Capt. Kidd came from old
 that I knew y^e B. Bradley as afores^d. belong to y^e P. Kidd's
 Ships & told me severall Questions concerning him. I told
 him I had been severall Times on Board y^e P. Kidd's Ship
 in y^e Indies, where I saw y^e P. Bradley extremely Ill, and
 by Discourse of y^e B. Bradly had been so y^e most part of their
 Voyage, and y^e Depon^t. further saith, That when he saw
 him at St. Thomes he was in a worse condition than before
 and that y^e Govern^r afores^d told me that upon his being
 put on Shoar he brought him upon his Examination and that
 he could find nothing to Charge y^e P. Bradley wth. and that
 he was putt as Shoar upon the Point three Miles from the
 Town without any Thing to assist him with, and wth. much
 Persecution gave him his Chest & Cloths. And further I
 heard y^e Govern^r say that his bringing nothing a Shoar wth.
 him but his Chest & finding nothing to Charge him wth. by
 Examination. And believe him to be Innocent upon w^{ch}. Examⁿ.
 him: The Depon^t. further saith, That there happened to me
 three English Men of War whilft I y^e Depon^t. was there
 and after some Discourse wth. y^e Govern^r I said if there
 had not been one Capt. Kidd off his Harbour, he had them
 that there had: Then they asked if he or any of his Men
 had been on Shoar, he told there had & that y^e P. Kidd
 as afores^d & 4 more w^{ch}. came Passengers in y^e P. Ship
 from y^e Indies & that he had Examined them but particularly
 y^e P. Bradley being Kidd's Brother, & could find nothing
 to Charge him or them with, & y^e Depon^t. further saith
 That when he was on Board y^e P. Ship as afores^d. he heard
 y^e P. Ship's Company say, That y^e P. Bradley often Depos^d.
 of India, & further this Deponent saith that
 this Day personally appeared before me Capt. Tompkins
 Rogers & upon his Oath declared that the above
 Relation or Deposition is true in y^e Matter and
 Substance thereof.

 Hawkins Currier & Gunmaker of London have made certain
 Constitutions & Appointed, and by these Pres^{ts}. Do make certain
 Constitutions & Appoint George Deasly of South Carolina in
 Justice March my true and lawfull Attorney for me and in my
 Name and for my Uses to Collect Demand & Receive of May^r.
 Robert Danuell all Sum^s & Sum^s of Money any way due
 or belonging to me from y^e P. Robert Danuell upon my own
 particular Acc^t. and to Receive and take into his Custody all
 Goods & Merchandises in y^e Hands of y^e P. Robert Danuell that
 are upon my own particular Account and upon his Refusal to
 deliver y^e same and upon Sign^{ment} thereof by y^e P. Robert
 Danuell his Execut^r or Administrat^r for me & in my Name to the
 Sheriff, Impression, Impound & Proseque for y^e same & upon such
 Suit to proceed to Judgm^t. & Execution & thereupon y^e P. Robert Danuell
 his Execut^r and Administrat^r in Prison to hold & keep until such
 thereof be made wth. all Costs & Charges justly due & to be suffered
 by y^e P. Robert Danuell his Execut^r & Administrat^r out of Prison
 to discharge and Acquittances for y^e same or any Part thereof for
 me and in my Name to make, Seal & Deliver and also to do
 perform & execute all & every other lawfull & reasonable Act &
 Act w^{ch}.soever both for Obeying & Discharging of y^e same
 as shall be needfull to be done Giving & by the Pres^{ts}. y^e same
 unto my P. Attorney my full and absolute Power in y^e Sheriff
 and y^e P. Attorney shall
 lawfully do or cause to be done in or about y^e Premises by
 some of these Pres^{ts} by Witnesses whereof I have hereunto
 set my Hand & Seal y^e fourteenth day of June in y^e Seventh
 year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign Lord William the Third by the
 Grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King Defend^r.
