Morley of y^e Province of North Carolina & said Mary Linckley her certain Attorney, Executors Administrators Assigns & Assigns to y^e Daym. well & truly to performe & spend my self my heirs Executors Administrators firmly by these Pres^t. Sealed to my Seal & Dated y^e 21st day of June Anno D. 1700

Condition of y^e Obligation is Such y^e y^e above named Charles Chingswells his heirs Executors Administrators or some of them shall & so well & truly pay or cause to be paid unto y^e above named Mary Linckley her certain Attorney, Executors Administrators Assigns & Assigns y^e full & true Sum of three hundred Pounds Part. Money of y^e Province in manner & form following To wit Lay Ten Pounds of y^e Sum of three hundred Pounds at on or before y^e first day of October next ensuing y^e Date hereof & other three & thirty Pounds residue of y^e Sum of three hundred Pounds at on or before y^e first day of October y^e shall be in y^e years but Lord one thousand seven hundred & one to one fraud or default Then this Obligation to be void or else to remain in full force & virtue until y^e Delivered to Cap^t. Thomas Mann or y^e Mary Linckley in y^e Presence of us y^e Richard Phillips

Read that on y^e Nineteenth day of January Anno Dom. 1699 & in y^e Eleventh year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign Lord William the third by the grace of God of England Scotland France of Ireland King. Defender of the Faith &c. Before me James Pickles Notaryes Publick dwelling in London by Royal Authority Admitted & Sworn in y^e Presence of the Wines hereafter named Personally appeared John Meriden. Citizen & Gentleman of London. who declared to have made. Ordained & Constituted & by these Pres^t. To Make Ordain & Constitute Cap^t. Thomas Mann Commander of y^e Edward and Frances now bound at on a Voyage to Carolina his true & Lawfull Attorney giving & by these Pres^t. granting unto his Attorney full Power & Lawfull Authority for him y^e Constituant in his name & to his use to ask demand Levy, & by all Lawfull waies & means recover and receive so from James Smith late of London Merchant & of y^e Province of North Carolina of what degree or Quality soever whom it doth or may concern Inhabiting in Carolina & foret. All & every such Sum & Sums of money goods Wares Merchandises Efferts. State & things what soever in y^e James Smith now doth or shall hereafter owe & stand indebted or have in their hand Custody or Possession to him y^e Constituant belonging or in any wise appertaining either by Bond Bill Book Account or otherwise how soever & nothing Excepted nor reserved And to that End with y^e James Smith & all & every other Person or Persons whom it shall & may concern to account & to view settle & adjust all Act^s & y^e Balances thereof to receive. Receive Recoveries & Receipts to give one or more acquittances & other sufficient Discharges in Due forme of Law But in Case of refusal or Delay by y^e James Smith or any Person or Persons to make Paymt. & Satisfaction in y^e Premises him her or them thereunto to compell by all Lawfull waies & means to soever also if need be to y^e Court of y^e Province in any Court of Law there to answer Defend & reply in all Matters & Causes touching or concerning y^e Premises to do Lay Pursue Implead Seize Sequester and Imprize & Condemn. Cont of Prison against Delict & Generally in & concerning y^e Premises to do Perform & Execute all or soever shall be requisite & necessary as fully & amply & Effectually to all Intents & Purposes whosoever
