Said Negro man Tikey shall att any time within the said
Term of four years be lawfully Convicted before any Justice
of the peace of any Misdemeanour done or Committed to me
in Respect of his not obeying or working for me honestly
Said Term Then these presents to be void and of none effect
as if y' same had never been made otherwise to be in full
force and Virtue In Witness whereof I have hereunto
put my hand and Seale the Eleventh day of May Anno
