Berke County in Province of South Carolina on^t ninth day of March anno D^r 1701
Personally came & appeared Denis Delahar of y^e City of New York in America born in
y^e said Province of Carolina Marin of full age who upon his oath on y^e bly oaths
of Almighty God taken to the Court at this time in y^e Month of April in y^e year above
said 1699 being a Passenger from y^e Island of Madagascar in y^e Ship known by Name
of y^e Adventure whereof was Master & Commander Capt William Kidd Royal Appointed
very well knew Samuel Bradley now before me likewise personally present then on board
of said Ship who at this appeared Coming on board of said Ship was very dangerously
ill, so much that he was unfit & incapable of performing any y^e least office or service
on Board and this appearred seeing of said Bradley under such circumstances had y^e
Priority of aiding some of y^e People then on board how long of said Bradley sick
and they told him for a Considerable time past

I N d^r this appearred further deponeth upon his oath that after y^e said Kidd
arrived with his said Ship near to any of y^e King of Englands Plantations he y^e
said Bradley did mightily urge & vehemently press y^e said Kidd to go into some
English port & more particularly into Antigua & deliver up of said Ship Adventure
to y^e Govr^r by him to be kept till he shold receive Orders from y^e Owners of y^e Ship
they went out of England in but y^e said Bradley had no other returns for this his
his good advice than Burings & revalings And Moreover of said Appereare with
that he very well knows that y^e said Bradley continued sick & weak from y^e said
Island of Madagascar to y^e Island of St. Thomas where y^e said Bradley after y^e great
Inconvenie & earnest Importunitie had with y^e said Kidd at length prevailed with
him that he might go on shore which he did sometime in y^e month of April then
D^r 1699 upon about a boit three miles Distance from y^e Town And this Day
heard y^e Boatman of y^e said Ship by name Michael Kalanay swear that he
y^e said Bradley should carry nothing on shore with him but his Chest & that indeed
Bradley had nothing delivered to him but his Chest as afores^d And further
