Know all Men by these Pres^{ts} That John Blake Esq^r am lawfully and firmly Bound unto Mr. John Alexander Esq^r in Charles Town in y^e full and just Sum of Twelve Hundred fifty Eight Pounds & seventeen Shillings four Pence to be paid by y^e John Alexander his heirs & Administrators or Assignes for y^e wth Paym^t well and truly to be made; I And my self my Heirs Executors and Administrators by these Presents Sealed with my Seal and Dated this 25th Day of Decem^r 1698

WHEREAS Francis Turgis Gent. late of this Province deceased intestate by means whereof the Administration of y^e Turgis Estate was committed to Elizabeth Turgis relict of y^e Turgis whereas y^e Turgis left two Daughters by Name Elizabeth and Mary to whom by Right and Law two thirds of the Estate of the Turgis doth belong, with Estate in y^e whole of y^e Appraisment amount to y^e Sum of nine Hundred forty and four Pounds and three Shillings and whereas there is an Intermarriage entered between y^e abovebound Joseph Blake and the abovebound Elizabeth Turgis relict of y^e Turgis. And the Effect of the above Obligation is such that if y^e abovebound Joseph Blake his Heirs, Executors Administrators or Assignes shall well and truly satisfy and pay unto each of y^e abovenamed Elizabeth & Mary Turgis the Sum of Three Hundred and fourteen Pounds four Shillings and four pence respectively as they shall Arrive at y^e Age of Twenty one years or so married it shall first happen and in the next Time shall give and Allow without any Charge to y^e said Children or either of them such Maintenance and

Education in this Country as shall be thought by y^e said Elizabeth Turgis Mother of y^e Children and y^e abovenamed John Alexander or either of them, then this Obligation shall be void in all Remembrance save & otherwise
