Cary his Execut^r & Administrat^r in this to hold & keep until paym^t thereof be made to all cost & Damages sustained & to be susteyned by occasion of y^e same & Upon Paym^t thereof y^e Tho. Cary his Execut^r & Administrat^r fortho^r Prison to Discharge & Acquittance for y^e same or any Part thereof for me in my Name to Make Seal & Deliver, And also to do Performe & execute all & every Other lawfull & reasonable acts & things to sooth for Obtayning & Discharging of y^e same, as shall be needfull to be done, giving & by these Pres^t, Granting unto my P^t Attorney my full & absolute Power in y^e premises, Ratifying & holding firmallie w^t soever my P^t Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or ab^t Premises by Virtue of these Pres^t, W^t Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal y^e twentieth day of March in y^e tenth year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign, Ed^r William of thrid^r y^e free of God of England, Scotland, France & Ireland King Defend^r of y^e faith ec^c Anno d^r Domini 1687 - - - - -

An Act for y^e Naturalizing of James Dufay
(Theodore Johnson and Others)

Humblye Presenteth your most
Excellent Majestie, y^e Lordes spiritual & temporal & Commons in this
Pres^t Parliament Assembled, James Dufay, Sonn of James Dufay by
Judith Doguer his Wife, born at Bologna in France, James
Le Serurier, Sonn of Iaines Le Serurier by Elizabeth Leger his wife
born at St Quentin in France, & others being all Persons come out of
his Majesties allegiance, but Professing y^e true Protestant Religion
& having given good Testimony of their humble Dutifull & Loyall
Affection to his Majestie & y^e good of y^e Kingdom of England That
it may be enacted & be it enacted by y^e Kings Most Excellent
Majesty, by and w^t y^e Advice & Consent of y^e Lordes spiritual &
Temporal & y^e Commons in this Pres^t Parliament assembled & by
y^e Authority of y^e same, That James Dufay, James Le Serurier &
Others before mentioned, Adjudged & taken to all Intents & Purposes
naturalized Englishmen born of this Kingdom of England & they are of fact
to be from henceforth adjudged reputed & taken to be in every Condition & respect
& degree, as free to all Intents & Purposes & Constructions as if they
every of y^e had been & were born to in this Nation or Kingdom of England
And be it further enacted, Declared & Ordained by y^e Authoritie aforesaid
that y^e James Dufay, James Le Serurier & others shall be
bereft enabled & adjudged adable, to all Intents, Purposes & Considera-
tions, to whom as well to demand Challenge, cause, take, retaine
have & enjoy, any Mannours, Lands, Tenements, hereditam, & all
other Priviledges, & Immunitiess, belonging to y^e Englishe People &
Natural Subjects of this Kingdom, to make, bise, her, or their issue
or Pedigree, as heire to him, her, or their Ancestors, Lineall or Collateral
brother of any Disent, remainder, reverter, right or Title, Conveyance
Legacy, or bequest to sever, in mayor shall from henceforth, never
remain, revert, accrue, or grow unto y^e, & every of y^e as also from
henceforth to haue, retain, keepe & enjoy all Mannours, Lands, Tenements
hereditam, to he, she or they, may or shall haue by way of
Purchase or Gift of any Person or Persons whatsoever as also to
