Island of Barbados Gentleman Greeting &c. Know ye
That I the said George Duncan for Divors Good Causes
and Considerations me thenceunto moving have made
ordained and Constituted and in my stead and place with-
and Deputed And by these Presents do make Ordained and
Constituted and in my stead &c placed put and deputed my good
and Trusty friend John Garvey Mariner to be my Agent
and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my Name and to my only
use benefit and behoof to ask Demand &c required Sud for
Recover and Recove of and from William Smith of
Charleston Towne in the Province of Carolina Merchant
the summe of two hundred and eighty pound Sterl
Good and Current Money Due to me the said Constituted
for non payment of Two hundred & forty pounds of
Pounds money on the seventeenth day of April one thousand
six hundred Ninety & three by one obligation with
Condition thereto written bearing Date the sixteenth
of January 1693 duly proved and Recorded in the
Procuratorys office of that Province as in and by the said
Provision of Constitution / Relation being therunto annexed
and at Large appeared / Giveng. And by these Presents
Leaving unto me said Attorney full and sufficient power
and Lawfull Authority to ask Demand &c Received of me
from his said self William Smith the said summe of two hundred
and eighty pounds due as aforesaid. By other wile to sue
him and make inquest and if need shall be him the said
William Smith to arrest attch him upon his demand. The
afore payment or other fild & action him to collect etc
assistance or assistance for other lawfull Discharges for me
and in my Name to give, Attorney or Attorneys and or more
wards him with full or limited power to make & publish
any thing to recover and miscall my Name to me self us
etc and my Person to represent in all Courts of Law or Equity
in behalf of all Governors Commissioners Judges and Justices
or others whom it shall or may Concerned & lawfully be
executed whereabout or compairnt etc determined and doth in
the County of Barbados and other parts in Barbados
not and to things there Divers & divers in the
and which for the Recovery of their Debts

Amplly and effectually in evry respect as to my selfe
my self or Couds do. wro' p from time to time affixing there
Ratifying and Allowing confirming and approbating of his Good
firme and stable in th' law all and what soever my said Attorney
that Lawfully do's or cause to be done in or about th' premises
by virtue of those ff' fons. In witness whereof I

affixed my Seal the sixteenth day of October in the sixth
year of their Majes Reigne King William & Queen Mary
