Instrument of writing shall come I George Duncan of the
Island of Barbados sendeth Greeting &c. Know yee
That I the said George Duncan for Divers Good Causes
and Considerations mo^{re} thovunto moving, have made
ordained and constituted and in my Steads and place put
and Deputed, And by those Persons do make ordain and
constitute and in ^{my} Steads & place put and depute my good
and Trusty friend John Garvey Marriner to be my true
and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my Name and to my only
use Benefit and behoof to aske Demand & require Sud for
Recover and Receive of and from William Smith of
Charles Towne in the Province of Carolina Merchant
the summe of fower hundred and eighty pound Sterl:
Good and Current Money Due to me the said Constituant
for non payment of Two hundred & forty pound of
like money on the Seventh day of Aprill, one thousand
six hundred Ninety & three, by one obligation with
Condition thereunder written bearing Date the Thirtieth
of January 1693 duly proved and Recorded in the
Secretarys office of that Province (as in and by the said
obligation & Condition (Relation being thovunto had) will
fully and at Large appeare) Giving, and by those Persons
Granting unto my said Attorney full and absolute power
and Lawfull authority to aske Demand & Receive of and
from the said William Smith the said summe of fower hundred
and eighty pound due as aforesaid, or otherwise to sue
implead and make answer, and if need shall be him the said
William Smith to arrest attach imprison & condemn, to
obtain payment or other satisfaction him to satisfy, and
acquittance or acquittances for other Lawfull Discharges for me
and in my Name to give, Attorney or Attorneys one or more
under him with full or limited power to make & prosecute
inquire to recover and make with my Name to make use
of and my self to Represent in all Courts of Law or Equity
and before all Governors, Commissioners Judges and Justices
or others whom it shall or may Concern and Generally to
execute prosecute, compromise, set off determine, and do all
and every such matters and things as he or they shall
think and thinke things Reasonable to be done in the
Lawfull manner for the Recovery of the said Debt &c

My said Attorney shall think fitt and necessary as fully
Ample and effectually in every respect as by my self
might or could doe: were I from time to time personally
Ratifying and Alloweing. confirming and approving of his Good
firmes and Stables in the Law all and what soever my said Attorney
shall Lawfully doe or cause to be done in or about the Premises
by virtue of those Powers. In Witness whereof I
tho' said George Duncan. have hereunto sett my hand and
affixed my Seale the sixteenth day of October in the sixth
yeare of their Maj^{ties} Reigned King William & queen Mary.
