bearing my name & for my use to administer & receive of & from Richard Hall
at Charles Town in Carolina of & of from any person or persons whatsoever
all such money goods or merchandizes in y^e course of right belongs or shall of right
belong to me And upon Non Paym^t thereof of said Richard Hall or any of
theirs Esqrs or Agents, for me & in my name to me more Imprison, Implead
& prosecute for y^e same & upon such Suit to proceed to Indict, & Execution
thereof of said Richard Hall or any of their Esqrs & others, in Province to
be & keep until Paym^t thereof be made withall Costs & damages sustained
to be sustained by occasion of y^e Detaining of y^e same And upon Paym^t
thereof of said Richard Hall or any of their Esqrs & others forth of Prison to Dis-
charge as Accomplices & Accessories for y^e same & any part thereof
for me & in my name to make Seal & Deliver, And also to Performe
execute all other lawfull & reasonable Acts or things whatsoever
both for Obtaining & discharging of y^e same as shall be needfull to be
done, & I do by these presents Granting unto my said Attorney my
full absolute power in the Province, Ratifying & holding firm all &
whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about
the Premises by Virtue of these presents, On W^e the 1st day of May
benevolent I set my hand & Seal y^e first day of May in y^e thirteenth year
of reign of our Sovereign Lord William the Third by the Grace of God of
England Scotland France & Ireland King Defender of y^e Faith etc: May
1701.

beloved friends of home Joseph Morton One of y^e Land^s of Carolina Law^r Pro-
fession & Samuel Booth Merch^t my true & lawfull Attorneys & Comissaries hereby
Impowering them or any two of them & said Joseph Morton being one of them may name
receive pursue, Examine Correct & pass over with Capt. Thomas Brughton my Agent
for Plantations & Stock belonging to Weston Hall and Black Robins at Brookhill
or also other my Estate in y^e said Province under the care or Management as Cyloneles
of y^e same made & passed y^e fifteenth day of September one thousand P^o hundred
and Ninety four between my said Husband & son of said Capt. Brughton, hereby
giving them of said Joseph Morton, Lewis Daingerfield & Samuel Booth or any
two of them & said Joseph Morton being one full power to Examine & pass over
over with Capt. Thomas Brughton in y^e Month of May & June annually which
Act^t being thus Examined allowed & under their hands Seals passed, or passed under
y^e hands & Seals of two of them of said Joseph Morton being me, And if there passes
y^e same being paid unto y^e said Lewis Daingerfield my Officer or unto whom
else I may Appoint to receive y^e same according to y^e last Article of y^e said
Indented Agree^t I do hereby give & Grant unto them my said Attorneys or
any two of them of said Joseph Morton being one full power to pay & allow to
my Agent Capt. Thomas Brughton or to me first part of y^e said Negroes
falling in y^e said Plantations & Stock by him managed as by y^e said reated Article
More at large appears relation being therunto had, & hereby ratifying before
writing or holding valid all that my said Attorneys and Commissioners or any two
of them of said Joseph Morton being one shall lawfully do or cause to be done
in y^e Province pursuant to y^e before recited Articles or instructions, & hereby
further giving & granting to my said Attorneys & Commissioners or any two of them
of said Joseph Morton being one full power to take demands & services attorney
& debts that was due to my late husband in Carolina whether monys due by
Bond, Bill or other Acc^t whatever, And also all monys & debts of what nature
& kind soever that now are or shall at any time hereafter become due to me
from any person or persons by any means whatsoever, & hereby giving & further
granting to my said Attorneys & Commissioners or any two of them of said Joseph
Morton being one full power & authority for me in my name to stand &
appear before all Judges & Ministers of y^e Law whatsoever in respect of sumis^s
as of Capt. shall require, and if need be to sue, Arrest, Implead, & into Prison to pay
any Person or Persons that owe or shall owe any Money or Debts, to me

with
