our trusty friend Michael Cole Master of good ship friends Alouette to be
our true & lawfull Attorney for us & in our names & for our use to ask demand
recover & receive of & from James Riddle of South Carolina Master all such
such sum & sums of Money debts, dues good wares, claims & demands
whatever as is pertaining unto us or either of us as Execut^rs to said William
Coles deceased, or otherwise howsoever & upon non paymt thereof of said James
Riddle his Exors & Adm^r for us & in our names to sue arrest, Imprison, &
& reexecute for & sum & upon such suit to proceed to Judg^m & Execution, &
thereupon of said James Riddle his Exors & Adm^r in prison to hold & Rec^m
Pay^m thereof be made with all Costs & damages incurred & to be sustained
by occasion of Retaining of said sum, And upon Pay^m thereof of said James
Riddle his Exors & Adm^r forth of Prison to discharge & acquittances for
said sum or any part thereof for us & in our names to make, Seal & Deliv^r
