 Personally appeared Jane Rymer sole Attorney Lawfully Deput
 by Jane his Wife: now at Widdby in y^e County of York
 naturall & lawfull Mother of Joth Robert Rymer late of Wales
 (in Parts beyond y^e Seas) a Batchellor dect. And also as Dem
 nistrating for by Use & Benefitt & during the Absence of the
 S^d Jane Wife of all and singular y^e Goods, Right & Credits of
 y^e S^d Deced^d Robert Rymer, as may appear by Letters of
 Administration Granted under y^e Seal of y^e Court of Chancery
 Court of Canterbury bearing date y^e day next before the
 date hereof) Which I appear hath Made, Judged and
 Constituted and by these Pres^{ts} hath Made, Ordained and
 Constituted Cap^t James Ribbe & Mr Alexander Parry of
 Carolina jointly & severally her true & lawfull Attornies and
 Attorney giving unto them & either of them full Power
 and Authority for and to y^e Use of y^e S^d Jane Wife, To Make
 Demand, Sue for, Recover & Receive all and singular y^e
 Rights & Credits of & belonging to y^e Estate of y^e S^d Deced^d
 Robert Rymer. But more particularly to Demand, sue
 and Receive of and from William Parry of Carolina afore
 sa^d of his heirs, Executors or Assigns that or State the Sum
 of Forty seven Pounds, Eight Shill^{ings} & Seven Pence half
 Penny at five shill^{ings} each, Piece of Eight, which the S^d Jane
 Received immediately after y^e Deced^d of y^e S^d Robert Rymer
 as Part of y^e S^d Rymer's Estate together wth all other
 Damages & Interests. Upon the Recovery or Receipt
 to Make & give due & sufficient Acquittances & Dis
 ch^{arges}. And (if needfull) to appear & be Escon of y^e S^d Jane
 Constituant, to Represent in all Courts & before all Just
 Govern^{rs}, Judges & Justices convenient, and to P^{ro}secute
 Implead, Seize, Sequester, Attach, Arrest, Imprison and

Condemn, and out of Prison again (when need shall be) to
 Deliver: Cum facultate Substituendi: And Generally in
 & concerning y^e Premises & y^e Dependancy to do, Suffer
 Transact & Accomplish (as well judicially as extra ju
 dicially) so far as y^e Constituant her self (in her Capacity
 afores^d or either of them) might or could do Personally.
 She hereby Promiseins to hold & Ratify for good & valid
 whosoever her S^d Attornies or either of them their or
 either of their Substitutes shall lawfully do or Cause
 to be done in y^e Premises by Vertue hereof. In
 Witnes^s whereof the S^d Constituant hath hereunto
 Set her Hand & Seal the day & Year first above
 Written in y^e Presence of John Ruel & Jeremiah
 Colborne Witnesses/
