 Virtue of a Power under y^e hand & Seale of my Husband Ralph Willson bearing date the
 thirteenth day of March Anno D. 1699 That I Jane Willson for & in Consideration of the
 Sum of two hundred & five payed full money to me in hand paid at & before y^e bearing
 & Delivery of these presents by Mayor Robert Daniell of this Province y^e Receipt whereof
 I do hereby Acknowledge & that I am fully Contented & paid, Well given, granted &
 Bargained & sold & by these presents I do Give, Grant, bargain sell Alien, Releas, Confirm, Assign
 & Let over unto y^e said Robert Daniell his Heirs & Assignes for ever all
 that piece or parcel of Land on which I lately dwelt & is lying & being in Litchfield
 Island containing two hundred Acres & adjoining to y^e lands of him y^e said Robert Daniell
 & was formerly bought by Nicholas Abbott of & from y^e said Daniell And y^e said Jane
 Willson do for my Husband & myself our heirs & Assignes Covenant promise Grant &
 Agree to with y^e said Robert Daniell his heirs & Assignes shall & may lawfully from
 time to time & at all times hereafter for ever have hold occupy possess & enjoy y^e said
 two hundred acres of Land together with all y^e houses edifices & buildings without y^e
 Let Suit, hindrance or trouble of us y^e said Ralph or Jane Willson or heirs or
 Assignes or any other Person or Persons whatsoever Claiming any right or Interest in
 or to y^e same or any part thereof And y^e said two hundred acres of Land are free of lease
 from all manner of Debts & Incumbrances whatsoever & it shall be kept for ever by us
 y^e said Jane Willson my heirs & Assignes For y^e true performance whereof I bind myself
 my heirs & Assignes unto him y^e said Robert Daniell his heirs & Assignes in y^e Sum of
 one thousand pounds Sterl. money of England In Witness whereof I have hereunto
 Set my hand & Seale this fifteenth day of July Anno D. 1699
