Know all men by these Presents That I James Alford of Barbados Merchant am Hold and firmly bound unto Abraham Parris of Barbados Merchant in the full and Just summe of Sixtie Two pounds Currant money of Carolina to be paid to the said Abraham Parris or to his Certain Attorney his Executors Admints or assigns to the which payment well and truly to be made. Giving my selfe my Heires Executors and Admints firmly by these presents Signed with my hand & Sealed with my Seale. Dated this thirteenth day of August 1694

The Condition of the above written obligation is such that if the above bound James Alford his Heires Executors and Admints doe and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Abraham Parris or to his Certain Attorney his Executors Admints or assigns the full and Just summe of Thirtie one Pounds two shillings Currant Money of Carolina upon demand without fraud or Deceit then the above obligation to be void or else to stand remaine and be in full force and virtue
