and Inhabitant greet you. That by a good I James Leroch in consideration that
now and read me hundred pounds Sterling of Richard Wakefield & Rebecca his wife
in y^e Province of Carolina afore. & Planter have bargained sold & delivered by
these Presents to Bargain, sell & deliver unto y^e said Richard Wakefield & his wife
Wakefield their Exors. Admors & Assignes for ever my Plantation with my Negro
Ned, Cager, Tom, and one negro now in my Possession. I have & will sell & have
bargained Premises & every part thereof freely, clearly & absolutely wth out
any & every use of y^e said Richard Wakefield & Rebecca his wife their Exors
Admors & Assignes for ever & not otherwise howsoever. And I y^e said James
Leroch for my self my Exors. Admors & Assignes doth hereby Covenant
that y^e said Richard Wakefield & his wife Rebecca Wakefield their Exors
Admors & Assignes for ever from & after y^e date hereof shall & may have
hold & Enjoy y^e said Bargained Premises aboves. free from all lawful
Claims & demands of any Person or Persons whatsoever from & or under me my
Exors. Admors & Assignes, & provided never the less that I James Leroch
my heirs. Exors. Admors & Assignes do keep & maintain y^e aboves. Richard Wakefield
during his natural life in meat drink washing & Lodging

 Sufficient for a man of his age to allow him one fat Steer every year & yearly
 during y^e Natural life of y^e said Richard Wakefield & also to pay unto y^e above
 Lebeach Wakefield ten pounds yearly & every year during her Natural life y^e
 Pymy to be made from y^e day of y^e date hereof & to pay her quarterly fifty shillings
 & every quarter y^e said sum of fifty shillings. And also y^e said Lebeach Wakefield we
 have y^e Indian Slave named Tiger during y^e natural life of y^e above Lebeach
 Wakefield with out y^e Lett hindrance or Molestation of me my heirs Executors
 Assignes And further I do Covenant for my self my heirs Executors Assignes
 to pay y^e Debt of y^e above Richard Wakefield which shall be due at y^e date hereof
 that then this Mortgage to be void & of none Effect or Elie to Stand in full force
 & Virtue In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand & Seal the

 Esquires & also to our high & lawful Attorneys for us in our Names & to
 our use to ask in for Levy, Recover & receive of y^e William Rumbell
 Commander of y^e Schooner Mincey nine pounds, ten shillings & four pence for
 lawful Money of England King so much due for a Bill paid by y^e said Capt.
 W^m Rumbell upon Stephen Dupont & Company Merch^{ts} in London which Bill was
 not provided with exchanges & reexchanges & charged on it at 18 p^{er} cent according
 to y^e custom of Merch^{ts} in y^e Island of Madera all which amounts to me hundred
 & seventeen pounds eight shillings & six pence & six farthings due for Levy, Recover
 & receive of James Dupont his Executors or Assigns. y^e More proceeds
 of ten pipes of wine furnished to him on y^e Mary & Elizabeth William Clay
 Master London at this Island of Madera y^e fifth of December 1698 & year
 Giving & granting to our said Attorneys & jointly & severally our whole
 full power & authority in & about y^e Premises & upon y^e receipt of any
 sum or sums receipt or receipts Acquittance or Acquittances discharge & satisfaction
 for us & in our names to make seal & deliver & call & every such Act & thing
 & devise & devise whatsoever in y^e Law for y^e recovery of y^e debts & sums above named
 for us & in our names to do execute & perform as fully largely & simply in every
 respect to all intents & constructions & purposes as we our selves might & lawfully do
 if we were personally present. And if need shal the Attorney or Attorneys to make power
 appoint ratifying, allowing & holding firm all & whatsoever our said Attorneys
 jointly & severally lawfully do or shall to be done in or about y^e Execution of the
 Premises by Virtue of this Power In witness whereof whereof we have hereunto
 our hands & seals In Funchall Island Madera y^e Eleventh of November Anno
 1698 & year.
