 of his last Will & Testament of J. S. Benjamin Pierpont late of New-
 Haven, Made, Ordained, Constituted and Appointed, and by these Pres.
 Make, Ordain, Constitute & Appoint my trusty friend Robert
 Fenwick of South Carolina aforesaid. Par. let to be my true, sufficient &
 lawful Attorney for me, in my Name & to my life in both or either
 of my Capacities aforesaid to Enter into & upon & Possession to Take of
 all and singular such Land, Tenement, Hereditament lying or being
 in South Carolina aforesaid, with all of Right belongs to my S. Brother
 Benjamin Pierpont at y. Time of his Death, & with do & ought
 unto to Defend & Charge to me y. Constituent, And y. Name
 to Empt, Grant, Bargain & Sell for such Sum & value of money
 and for such Term & Terms of Years as my S. Attorney in Per-
 son of y. Instructions to be by me unto him given in that respect
 shall think fit, And in my Name to make Seal & Execute
 the Deeds or other Writings necessary for y. Demise, Grant
 or conveying of y. same Land to Demand, Sue for, Recover
 & Receive all and singular such Debt & Debt, Sum & Sum of
 Money, Good, Ware, Negro, Effects, Rents & Advantages or
 Rent & other Estate & Goods w. were due, Owed or belonging
 unto my S. Brother at y. Time of his Death, & now Payable or belong-
 to me y. Constituent in either of my Capacities aforesaid from any
 Person or Persons in South Carolina aforesaid by any manner of
 way or Means w. hever. And upon his Receipt of y. same
 or any Part thereof Signatures or other sufficient Discharge
 for me & in my Name to Make, Seal & Execute & Give here-
 Granting unto my S. Attorney my full & whole Power & Au-
 thority in & about y. Premises And to Take & Use all proper way
 & Means & Course in y. Law (if Need be) for y. Obtaining and
 Recovery of y. same. And for me to Apppear y. Person or
 the Constituent in either of my Capacities aforesaid to Represent me
 any Court or Courts and before any Judge, Justice or other Officer or
 Ministers of y. Law whatsoever. Also one or more Attorney and
 one or same again at Pleasure to Revocate. And generally
 to Do, Say, Transact, Complain, Agree, Compromise, Finish & be
 with all & w. hever shall be requisite & necessary in & about y.

Premises as fully, amply & Effectually to all intents & Purposes
 as I my self might or could do being personally Pres. And
 Ratifying, Approving & Holding for good & valid for ever & aban-
 doning whatsoever my S. Attorney or his Substitute shall lawfully
 do or Cause to be done in or about y. Premises by Virtue
