 or other Discharges for me and in my name to make Seal & deliver.
 And further to do all other Acts, & things requisite to be done in and
 about the premises, in as full and Ample Manner And to all intents —
 Constructions and purposes as I might or could doo if in Person
 Ratifying, Allowing & holding firm & stable all and whatsoever
 my said Attorney shall Lawfully doo, or cause to be done in and
 about the premises by virtue of these presents. In Witness
