

Know all Men by these Presents that We Edward Crisp, Edmund Stagg & Edmund Stagg of y^e Parish of St. Paul Church Garden in y^e County of Middlesex Carpenters have made Ordinance Constitutions & Statutes & by these Presents do solemnly & severally make, Ordain Constitutions & Statutes Christopher Smith & John Pinckney of Carolina Merch.^t is either of them our true & lawful Attorney sitting jointly & severally for us & in our names & in y^e names of either of us & for our several & respective w^{ts} Subjects liable to Acc^t. & pay y^e Lawes to us our Exors or Assignes to ask demand & receive of Charles Olinnell of y^e said Province of Carolina all such Sums & Sums of Money, goods, wares, merchandises & other things which of us y^e said Edward Crisp & Edmund Stagg or either of us which y^e said Charles Olinnell hath in his hands or Possession or which at any time hereafter shall come to y^e hands or possession of y^e said Charles Olinnell & upon payment of y^e same y^e said Charles Olinnell his Exors & Assignes for us & in our names & in y^e names of either of us to sue, arrest, Imprison, Impledge & prosecute for y^e same & upon suit to proceed to Judgment & Execution, & thereupon y^e said Charles Olinnell his Exors & Assignes in prison to hold & keep until payment of y^e money or delivery of y^e goods made with all costs & damages incurred & to be sustained by securing y^e same of y^e same And upon payment or delivery of y^e same as aforesaid y^e said Charles Olinnell forthwith to discharge & acquittance for y^e same or any part thereof for us & in our several & respective names to make, seal, & deliver And to do, perform & execute all & every other lawful & reasonable Acts & things which both for obtaining & discharging y^e same or shall be needful to be done, giving by these Presents Granting unto our said Attorney & either of them our full power Cover in y^e Premises, Ratifying & holding firm all & whatsoever our said Attorney or either of them shall lawfully do or cause to be done in or about y^e Premises by virtue of these Presents In Witness whereof we have hereunto put our hands & Seals the one & twentieth day of November Anno Dom. 1699. & in y^e Seventh year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign Lord William y^e third King of England &c.

Robert Meares or any other Person or Persons to give a legal Acquittance or Acquittance, Discharge or Discharges for me and in my Name to make, sign, seal and Deliver and again at his Pleasure to revoke and further to Execute Perform and Finish for me and in my Name all and singular Things & Things w^{ch} shall or may be necessary touching & concerning the Premises as fully throughly and infinitely as if y^e John Foster in mine own person might or could do in or about y^e same Ratifying and Confirming whatsoever my Attorney shall do or cause to be done in the Premises by these Presents In Witness whereof I have set my Hand and Seal this Thirtieth day of Decem^r. WHEREAS Francis Turgis Gent. late of this Province deceased intestate by means whereof the Administration of y^e Turgis Estate was committed to Elizabeth Turgis relict of y^e Turgis whereas y^e T. Francis Turgis left two Daughters by Name Elizabeth and Mary to whom by Right and two two thirds of the Estate of the T. Francis Turgis doth belong, with Estate in y^e whole of y^e Appraisment amount to y^e Sum of nine hundred forty and four Pounds and three Shill. & this whereas there is an Intermarriage entered between y^e abovebound Joseph Blake and the abovebound Elizabeth Turgis relict of y^e T. Francis Turgis. And the Effect of the above Obligation is such that if y^e abovebound Joseph Blake his Heirs, Executors Administrat^r or Assigns shall well and truly satisfy and Pay unto each of y^e abovenamed Elizabeth & Mary Turgis the Sum of Three hundred and fourteen Pounds four Shill. and four pence respectively as they shall Arrive at y^e Age of Twenty one years or be married or shall first happen and in the mean Time shall give and Allow without any Charge to y^e said Children or either of them such Maintenance and

Education in this Country as shall be thought by y^e said Elizabeth Turgis Mother of y^e said Children and y^e abovenamed John Alexander or either of them, then this Obligation shall be void or else to remain in force & Virtue
