So it known & Manifest unto all those who shall see these Parts or hear y^e Same Read that on y^e Nineteenth day of January Anno Dom. 1699- in y^e Eleventh year of y^e Reign of our Sovereign Lord William the third by the grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King. Defender of the Faith &c. Before me James Puckle Notary Publick dwelling in London by Royall Authority Admitted & Sworn in y^e Presence of the Wines hereafter named Personally appeared John Maider, Citizen & Cutler of London, who declared to have made, Ordained & Conained & by these Pres^{ts} To Make Ordain & Constitute Cap^t Thomas Mann Commander of y^e Ship and Francis now bound on a Voyage to Cardina his true & Lawfull Attorney giving & by these Pres^{ts} Granting unto his Attorney full Power & Lawfull Authority for him y^e Constituant in his name & to his use to ask demand Levy, & by all Lawfull waies & means recover and receive so from James Smith late of London Merch^t & of y^e Province of y^e Persons of what degree or Quality soever whom it doth or may come inhabiting in Carolina &c. All & every such Sum & Sums of Money goods Wares Merchandises Effat, Effate & things whatsoever to y^e James Smith now doth or shall hereafter owe & stand indebted to him in their hand Custody or Possession to him y^e Constituant belonging or in any wise appertaining either by Bond Bill Book Account or otherwise howsoever nothing Excepted nor reserved And to that End with y^e James Smith & all & every other Person or Persons whom it shall or may concern to account & to view settle & adjust all Act^s & y^e Ballance thereof to receive, Upon Recoveries & Receipts to give one or more Acquittances wth sufficient Discharges in Due forme of Law But in Case of refusal or Delay by y^e James Smith or any Person or Persons to make Paym^t & Satisfaction in y^e Premises him her or them thereunto to be compelled by all Lawfull waies & means to soever also if need be to appear before all Courts Judges & Jurors in any Court or Courts there to Answer Defend & reply in all Matters & Causes touching or concerning y^e Premises to do any Pursue, Implead Seize, Sequester, and Imprize & Condemn, Court of P^{ro}vision to Deliver & Generally in & concerning y^e Premises to do Perform & Execute all or severall such & require necessary as fully Amply & Effectually to all Intents & Purposes as he
