Williams's Title to y^e Negro ag^t any Claim from any
Person or Persons w^{ch}soever.

is such that if y^e abovenamed John Millward shall by himself
or some other Person pay or cause to be paid to y^e J^r. James
Williams his Heirs or Assigns y^e Sum of One Hundred
pounds Curr^{nt} Money within Twelve Months after y^e date
hereof then this Deed of Sale is to be void or else of full force
and y^e J^r. Negro to be fully & absolutely to y^e J^r. James Williams
