Governor & Councill of the Province of Carolina bearing Date the tenth
day of October 1694. for the sume of Nine hundred & fiftie three
pounds. Seven shillings & Six pence with Costs of Court
The said Warren doth hereby acknowledge the Receipt thereof
and of the said Decree sume And all Accounts that have passed
between them to this present time doth fully acquitt & Discharge the
said Parrie. and in Testimony thereof hath he vount to sett his hand
& Seale in Charles Towne in Carolina the sixteenth day of October

Know all men by these presents that John Warren of New
Providence doe acknowledge to have Received of Capt. Abraham
Parrie of the Island of Barbados a Receipt under the hand of
M^r Armaduke freedman of the Island of Jamaica Attorney.
to say Parrie. for a Certaine bond under the hand & Seale of
Capt. James Riscoe bearing Date the 16th day of July past. for
four hundred & fiftie pounds Stere, payabld to said Abraham Parrie
or his assigns the foresaid Receipt being signed over to me for
my use. That is to say four hundred pounds Stere of said Bond
I have also a Bond under the hand & Seale of the said Abraham
Parrie bearing Date even with these presents payabld to me or
my assigns for the sume of Eight hundred pounds Stere, which is
for the performance of the foresaid assignment, that the said
four hundred pounds shal be paid unto the said Warren or order
by the Island of Jamaica. Now I doe promise unto the said
Abraham Parrie. That if in Case I doe not receive the said sume
of four hundred pounds of the foresaid freedman or his assigns
I will deliver unto him the said Bond Parrie the foresaid receipt
of Armaduke freedmans bearing Date 3rd of August last Past.

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 part. And alsoe further Acknowlege; that if I shall Receive the
 aforesaid sum of hundred Pounds Sterl. then the obligation that the
 said Abrah^m Parry has gave me under his hand & seal as aforesaid =
 in the Penalty of eight hundred pounds Sterl. for the performance
 of the aforesaid assignement or order, shall be for ever void and of
 none effect, to the true performance hereof, I bind my selfe, my heirs,
 Executors, Administrators, Assignes. Xirmely by these words
