 about 9 month of August 1697 being Master of your ship Colas Been Galley
 and being at that time with ys said ship in a Bay of alls, he ys said Deponenter
 was there offered, That in Case he would sell or dispose of ys said ship, The
 Pofferer would pay a sum to ys said Deponenter for y^e pricke value
 thereof of sum of Seaventeen hundred pounds of Current money of England
 but the Deponentes order from his master being not to dispose of her for
 less then of sum of two thousand pounds, so this Deponenter did receive of
 him sum of Seaventeen hundred pounds, and short afterward to this -
 Deponents knowledge there was paid out in Carpenters work done to her
 sum of One hundred pounds upwards besides other charges of fitting
 her out, And Joshua Pitt of London Gentleman aged twenty five
 years or thereabouts makest Oath that he was present & did see Benjamin
 Verrell John Gove Patrick Walsh & Iles Beech of London Merchants Signe, Seal
 and as their Acte & Deed deliver of letter of attorney now produced unto
 him fair & uncancelled bearing date y^e fifth day of September instant
 thereby Constituting & Appointing James Butler of London Merch.
 to be their true & lawfull Attorney for y^e purposes in y^e said Letter of Attorney
 particularly mentioned, and this Deponenter as a witness to y^e signing, sealing
 Delivering thereof did subscribe his name thereto as therby it doth
 may appear, And this Deponenter also saith that he did then see Peter
 de la Penne & John Glavell & other Subscribing witnessesse & subscribe
 their names to y^e said Letter of Attorney, All with a testimony whereof
 we your Lord Mayor & Aldermen have caused y^e seal of y^e Office of Mayoralty
 of y^e said City of London to be hereunto putt or affixed, and y^e said Letter
 of Attorney to be hereunto annexed, Sotld in London y^e Seaventh day of
 September Anne D^r 1701, and in y^e Thirteenth year of y^e Reign
 of our Sovereign Lord William, y^r 2d by y^e Grace of God King of England

To all People to whome these presents shall Come John Wick of London
 Esq^r Landeth greeting, Whereas John Earl of North Palatine & y^r rest of y^e his and
 absolute Lord & Prop^r of y^e Province of Carolina (in parts beyond y^e seas) in or by
 certaine Deed, Instrument, or Writing under y^e hande of y^e said Lord Prop^r & y^e Lady
 of y^e said Province bearing date y^e xxviith day of July which was in y^e year of
 our Lord 1700, for y^e Considerations therein mentioned, Did during their
 Pleasure, Posthaste & Appoint y^e said John Wick Secretary & Register of that part
 of their Province of Carolina that lies Eastward off Cape Fear, And did thereby
 Authorize & give him y^e said John Wick full power to be present at y^e meeting of y^e
 Palatine Court & Grand Council, and also to do performe & execute divers other acts
 Writters & things therein mentioned, And also all other acts & things that have been
 usually done in that part of their provinces afores. By former Secretaries and
 Register, And also to take all such fees & exquittis as to y^e office of a Secretary
 Register did belong, And Whereas y^e said Lord Prop^r of y^e said Province of Carolina
 did in or by one or more other Deed, Instrument, or Writing under their handes & seals
 bearing date y^e said 27th day of y^e Month of June 1700, made an
 Ordinance or Decree certaine rules orders or Directions to be
 observed by y^e said John Wick in & during his Secretary & Register office
 And did therby also declare their will to be that y^e said John Wick should have a
 Salary of forty pounds of Ann, paid him half yearly out of the publick Treasury of
 Carolina by their Treasurer for y^e time being to commence from y^e time of his entame
 on his office, as by y^e said several Instruments or Writing relation being unto them
 respectively had more plainly may appear Now I WITNESS Y^r LLE That y^e said John
 Wick for divers good Causes & valuable Considerations him therunto moving on
 Earth made, nominated, constituted appointed Authorized & Empowered by these
 presents Both make nominate constitute appoint Authorize & Empower William
 Allen of London gent, to be his true lawfull, absolute, & irreversable Attorney, Deputy
 or Surrogate for & in y^e name, place & stead of him y^e said John Wick but to act for the
 only proper use & behalfe of him y^e said William Allen his Esq^r & Admir^r, to act
 performe & execute y^e said Office & place of Secretary & Register, & to ask, demand, ha
 for receive & receive & enjoy y^e said yearly sum or Annual salary of forty
 pounds, and all & every y^e fee, perquisite, Emolument, Profit, & Advantages which
 shall or may from & after y^e first day of November next ensuing y^e Date of
 these presents, be had or made or be due, payable or recoverable or do or shall
 or may belong or in any wise appertain or ought to appertain to y^e said John
 Wick or his Attorney, Deputy or Aliogue or Surrogate, for or in respect of his

 from time to time or at all times during continuance in force of said Commission
 Deputation or Instrument for Empowering said John Wick to be Secretary &

 matters & things needfull or requisite to be done and Executed in or about
 Performance Execution & Discharge of said Office or place of Secretary and

 Executed all & every other reasonable Act & thing for y^e further better
 enabling, Authorizing & Empowering him y^e said William Allen to be his absolute
 Deputy Attorney & Prorogate in this behalf for y^e Executing having and
 Receiving & Enjoying y^e said Secretary & Registers Office at place and
 Annual sum, Profits & p^rfer, Promises to his own use for such
 time & in manner as aforesaid y^e Commiss of y^e said William Allen shall
 direct, On W^tch wheret y^e said John Wick hath hercunto sett
 his hand & Seal y^e four & twentieth day of July Anne d^r 1708. 2
