Reports & our William one other Executor of y^e said Thomas Carter our & both & either of our true & lawfull Attorney to demand recover & receive in his own & our names & stead but to y^e uses & Intent of y^e said last Will & Testament of y^e said Thomas Carter all & every sum & sum of money whatsoever due & owing to us or either of us in Acc^t of y^e said Thomas Carter & for y^e recovery thereof by these presents have given & granted to our said Attorney our full & whole Authority for default of Payment every & every & Person indebted as aforesaid their heirs Executors & Assigns by whom made to Arrest & Imprison again to deliver & release & their or any of their goods & Chattels lands & tenements to be attached seized or extended & placed in execution & later whatsoever against them or any of them in execution of goods Chattels & Debts of them or any of them for any Debt or Debts of y^e said Thomas Carter & to cause to maintain & prosecute in any Court or Courts whatsoever & upon recovery or receipt of any sum or sums of Money Legittimate or Legittimate Release or releases or other discharges to deliver & send or more Attorney or Attorneys to substitute further to us & do all lawfull doings & things in y^e premises as to him shall seem meet & convenient & to certify & by these presents confirming all lawfull Acts & Deeds as y^e said True Williamson shall do or cause to be done in y^e Premises And y^e said Mary Carter doth hereby for herself her heirs & Assigns & Covenant promise & grant to & with y^e said True Williamson his heirs & Assigns that they the said Mary Carter her heirs & Assigns shall & will save harmless & reparaundmised y^e said True Williamson his heirs & Assigns & from all Costs charges & expenses that shall or may happen for & in prosecution of y^e premises & any suit or suits in or about y^e premises And y^e said Mary Carter doth hereby further promise & agree & allow unto y^e said True Williamson fifteen pounds out of y^e first one hundred pounds of y^e said Carters Estate as shall be gotten in for his pains care & trouble in prosecution of these presents & five pounds more when he shall have gotten in y^e remainder of y^e said Estate & make it

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appear before two honest neighbours that he y^e said True Williamson hath used lawfull & lawfull means to gett in y^e same.  Executors or Assignors, but also of & from all & every other person or persons in
 South Carolina whom it shall or may Concern all & every such sum &
 sums of Money goods wares, merchandizes, effects, Estates & things
 whatsoever nothing excepted nor reserved which y^e said Jonathan Amory
 or Peter Lasalle or either of them their Executors or Assignors & all others
 whom it shall or may Concern now, do or shall hereafter owe & stand
 indebted or have in their hands Custody or possession to y^e said Appraisers
 & rest of y^e said Company of Merchants belonging & in any wise operating
 for or by what reason or means never nothing excepted nor reserved
 Also with y^e said Jonathan Amory & Peter Lasalle their heirs
