recovery thereof by these presents have given & granted to our said
Attorneys full & whole Authority for behalf of Pennon all & every
Person & Persons intitled to enforce their heire, Passes & Admors, by their bodies
to Arrest & Imprison vagans to deliver & release, & their or any of their
goods & Chattells, lands & tenement to be attached Seized or Executed or pleas
prosecutions & suits whatever against them or any of them or against
goods Chattells, Recnts & Debts of them or any of them for any debt or debill
of said Pennon Carter to commence maintain & prosecute in any Court or
Courts whatsoever, & upon Recovery or Receipt of any sum or sums of Money
Agreement or Settlements Release or releases or other discharges to render
Deliver & exec more Attorney or Attorneys to substitute further to us
& to all lawfull debts & things in y^e premises as to him or them seem most
convenient, certifying & by these presents Confirming all lawfull debts
deeds as y^e said Mr Williamson shall do or cause to be done in y^e presence
(but y^e said Mary Carter doth hereby for herself her Passes & Admors &
Covenant promise & grant to & with y^e said Mr Williamson his Execut^t
Admors, that she & said Mary Carter her Execut^t & Admors shall & will
have harmless & indemnified y^e said Mr Williamson his Passes &
Admors, & from all Csts, charges & minis to them shall or may happen
for & in prosecution of y^e premises & any suit or suits in or about y^e same
And y^e said Mary Carter doth hereby further promise & agree to allow
unto y^e said Mr Williamson fifteen pounds out of y^e first one hundred
pounds of y^e said Execut^t Estates as shall be gotten for his pass, car
& trouble in prosecution of these presents & five pounds more unto
who shall have gotten in y^e remainder of y^e said Estate or make it

appear before two honest neighbours that he y^e said Mr Williamson
had used lawfull endeavours to gett my money. In Witness

their hands & seals this Seventeenth day of February Anno d^r 1700. & in
y^e tenth year of y^e reign of King William, y^e third of England &c.
