and Agree to & with y^e Robert Stevens his Heires and Assignes

Pth Robert Stevens his Heires & Assignes shall Warrant him
of and from all other Barganes & Sales by him y^e Pth Thomas
Barker of y^e afores^d Negroes shall & will keep clear, clean
and Defectless. Providedd also that if y^e afores^d Thomas
Barker his Heires, Executors Administrators or any
or any of them shall pay unto y^e Robert Stevens his Heires
Executors Administrators or Assignes y^e full Sum of Forty Pounds
in Dollars or Spanish Pieces of Eight weighing at least three
Penny weight each Piece of Eight at five Shill each Piece
or Piece of Eight on or before y^e twenty Eight day of January
next then this pres^t Writings of Bargane & Sale, shall be void
and of none Effect. Providedd also that if y^e afores^d Sum
of Forty Pounds as afores^d be not Paid at y^e Time afores^d
that if one or both of y^e Negroes prebargained shall die before
the Eight & Twentieth day of March afores^d Then y^e Pth Sarah
Barker in y^e Name of her Husband Thomas Barker
Covenant, Promise & Agree to & with y^e Robert Stevens
his y^e Robert Stevens his Heires & Assignes shall be paid
y^e Pth Forty Pounds by y^e Sale of Cattle or other Stock
wherever wth y^e Pth Thomas Barker doth belong with Interest

have & to hold the said Negro Woman and her Increase To
the y^e Thomas Summers his Heirs Executors & Assignes and
to their own proper Goods, Chattels, and to his and their own proper
Use, Benefit & School for ever. **Provided** always
that if y^e William Cay his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assignes
any of them do well and truly say or cause to be paid to y^e Thomas
Summers his Heirs Executors Administrators or Assignes of y^e full sum
of Eighteen Pounds in Spanish Piece of Eight weighing at least
Thirteen Penny weight or Lion Dollars at five Shillings each Dollar
or Piece of Eight, at or before y^e Seventh & Twentieth day of
June next ensuing y^e Date hereof without fraud or falsehood
then these Presents shall be void and of none Effect But
if Default of Payment of y^e sum of Eighteen Pounds in Span-
ish or in all be made by me y^e William Cay my Heirs Executors
Administrators or Assignes on y^e Day & Year aforesaid contrary to y^e Form aforesaid
