determine Petties & to all whom it may concern Greeting

Whereas our most Gracious Sovereign Lord King William did in his thirtieth
year of his Majesties Reign give out his Royal Proclamation & Act of Grace & mercy
dated at his Castle at Ressington on y^e 13th day of March anno: 1703 in which
(amongst other things there is contained) is set forth & expressed. That if any Person
or Persons serving on board any Ship or Vessel, shall at any time within two
months after issue of said Proclamation leave of Lame or repair to any of our Plant
Magistrates, Governors, Commanders or other Person in said Proclamation mentioned &
before them make Affidavit of Petties Committed by Ship or Vessel whereof they
belong or Person or Persons in leaving such Ship or making Affidavit, shall
have due gracious Pardon for of Petties Committed by him or them before y^e fourth
day of June next hundred & one upon a Certificate of his or their Pardon
& upon producing of same. We do hereby require our Judge or Judges of Admiralty in England
& elsewhere & all other Persons Empower'd by Commission to hear & determine Petties in
Europe, Africa & America to stay my further Proceedings against such Person or Persons
whilst produce such Certificate until heath they can produce his more gracious pardon as in
by y^e said Proclamation more fully & at large appears. And Willm: Anne: 13 Bradley M^r
now in the Province but late serving on board of Ship or Vessel called of Adventure whereof
Master or Commander Capt: William Kidd late late aforesaid of said Ship & is willing to submit
so favourable an opportunity of laying hold of those in said Ship most worthy of y^e said
Petties for to comply with y^e same. Now know ye this. Esq: James Moore
Governor as agent to Her Majesty & here, that y^e said Samuel Bradley hath in my Government
in this present day of September anno: 1703. Subscribed himself upon these his and Majesties most
gracious offers of grace, mercy & free Pardon & before me made Affidavit of Petties and
Robberies in said Ship Committed before y^e twenty fourth day of June 1703 & that he did belong to
y^e said Ship or Vessel. To the End of mine may appear I have granted these presents & a
Certificate of y^e said Samuel Bradley in Lame & place convenient. Given under my hand also
at Lame at Charles Town the third day of September anno: 1703. Anno Regni Ego
Gulielmi Secundi de Britia Anglia, Scotia, Irland, et Hibernia decimo tertio

Hence all a singular sum of money which y^e aforesaid John Child
of Boston hath rec'd for fifty two Pounds being y^e good fyre aforesaid
Bridgett Martin rec'd for my use And upon Non Paym: thereof paid John Child
of Boston his wife Elizabeth Adams for me in my name to take, demand, require
Impound & prosecute for y^e same & upon such time to proceed to Judgment & execution
& thereupon of y^e said John Child & his wife their Actions in prosecution
& keep until Paym: therof be made with all Costs & damages incurred as is to be
determined by Occasion of y^e Detaining of y^e same, And upon Paym: thereof of y^e said
John Child & his wife their Executor or Administratrix of y^e said John Child
& his wife y^e same or any part thereof for me in my name to make, take
& deliver & cause to perform & execute all & every other lawful & reasonable
Act or thing whatsoever both for obtaining & discharging of y^e same as shall be
needfull to be done. Given early this present year amongst my other Affairs
my full absolute Power in y^e managing satisfying & settling of all my troubles
by y^e said Attorney shall lawfully for a cause to be had in y^e reason of permission
by Virtue of these presents B. M^r witness whereof I have hereunto set my
hand & Seal: y^e fifth day of March in y^e thirteenth year of our Sovereign Lord
William: Third by y^e grace of God of England, Scotland, France & Ireland King
