Ame of my decease & to his heirs Execs, Admors, & Assignees to him & their uses prop
w^r w^r & benefits or behoofe for ever, Excepting y^e Corp of Corn & other Provisions which
at my decease shall or may come y^e said Plantation, In witness whereof I have affixed
my hand & seal to this 2^d day of October anno D^r 1700
