to me y^r Constituant due & owing or wh^t hereafter may to me be
payable & belonging whether it be by bill, book, specially Contract Ac-
count or by any other wyes or means whatsoever, And upon receipt
of y^r premises or any part thereof legittimacy or other lawfull diction
for me & in my Name to make Seal & Deliver & to Compose & Compr^e
clude & Agree as to my said Attorney shall seeme convenient & convenient
most for my Interest & Advantage, Doreby likewise Empowering &
Authorizing my said Attorney to take into her Custody Care & Manage
all my Estate in this Province whether Real or Personall or of what Nature
kind or Quality soever, & therem & therewith to Act ad as fully apply
fectually to all Intents Constructions & purposes as I my self might
or could do were I personally present And I do moreover Authorize
a Lawyer my said Attorney to Let, Lett, Sell, alien, Convey or
disposse of all or any part of my said Estate in Carolina whether Real

Personal or any person or persons willing to purchase y^r same their heirs and
Assigns for ever for such Consideration or sume of Money as my said
Attorney shall think Competent & sufficient to make sign, seal & deliver
such & so many Deeds of Sale or other Conveyances whatsoever for y^r same
& Actual Sealing & Conveying of y^r same as by Party or Party purchased
or by his or their Councill shall be reasonably devisor Advised or Required
Sole one Attorney or more under hand to make a Substitute at pleasure
again to Revode And Generally to do say Execute perfimfully full and
Accomplish all & every such Manner of thing needfull & necessary to be done
in & about y^r premises as fully compleat & effectually as I my self might
or could do personally, But if y^r said Attorney find a Valid & lawfull
my said Attorney other Substitutes shall lawfully do or cause to be done
