

This Writing of Agreement made the
 Thirteenth day of November, In the sixth year of the Reign
 of William & Mary King & Queen &c Anno Dom 1694 in
 Between Robert Ball of Sandford in the County of Lincoln
 Yeoman of the one part, And Catharine Colletton of London
 Spinster Daughter to Executrix of the last Will & Testament
 of Sir Peter Colletton late of the parish of St James Westminster
 in the County of Middlesex Barrister of the other part in
 Whereas the said Catharine Colletton by procuration or Letter
 of Attorney under her hand & Seal paid before Josiah Bonds
 of London Notary Publick and bearing date with those
 presents hath constituted and appointed the said Robert Ball
 her true and lawfull attorney amongst other matters & things
 therein contained to enter into and upon and take possession
 of all and every such Mchueages Lands Plantations & tenements
 and Hereditaments with the living & dead stock therunto
 belonging as the said Sir Peter Colletton was seized of at the time
 of his Death in Carolina or the places adjacent to territories
 therunto belonging and the same for and in the name of the
 said Catharine Colletton in her Capacitie of Executrix aforesaid
 or otherwise to manage & improve to be for
 the best profit & advantage of her the said Catharine Colletton
 in her said Capacitie or otherwise and to provide furnish &
 supply the same from time to time with all such for wants
 Slaves implements & stock and things what so ever
 as shall be needfull & requisite in that behalf as by the said
 Procuration or Letter of Attorney may at large appear relation
 being therunto had Now these presents witness
 and the said Robert Ball for the consideration herein after
 mentioned Both for himself his Executors and Administrators
 Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Catharine Colletton
 her Executors and Administrators by these presents In manner as followeth
 (that is to say) That he the said Robert Ball shall and will
 with all expedition possible after his arrival at Carolina
 aforesaid (whether he is now bound) use his best and utmost
 endeavour by all lawfull wayes to means possible at the
 proper costs & charges in the law of the said Catharine Colletton
 to execute or Administer to obtain & recover full & quiet
 possession of all and singular the said lands & plantations
 power and authority therunto belonging pursuant to the
 granted for that effect in and by the Procuration or Letter
 of attorney above Relited And also that he the said
 Robert Ball according to the best of his power shall & know
 shall and will with all expedition possible after his having
 recovered and obtained possession of the premises aforesaid
 take a true writing of all & every the Mchueages

Lands. Plantations. Bondments & hereditaments with the living
and Dead Stock therunto belonging. as the said S: Peter Colleton
Byrd Sirs of in Carolina aforesaid. or the places adjacent thereto
therunto belonging. And therof to make a full and true Schedule &
Inventory in writing. Mentioning the several dimensions of his
house and building of and belonging to the said Lands and plantations
with the particulars of all and every the household Goods utensils
implements and other furniture and things therunto belonging. also
also the number of acres of every plantation and piece or parcel
of the lands aforesaid. with the nature of the Soil Rendition and
the like therof. And also the particulars of all the servants slaves
and belonging to the said lands. their respective Sex. names & age
and of all the Horses. Cattle Hogs. and other living Stock. with
their respective species. And also of all other Stock and things
what so ever. Together with the particulars of all and every
the goods due and owing unto and from the lands & plantation
aforesaid. Which said Schedule & Inventory when compleated
and finished. he the said Robert Ball shall and will by the
next opportunity of shipping. Send and Transmitt the same with
one or more duplicates therof. All of one Date and signed by
him the said Robert Ball unto the said Catherine Colleton his
executors or assigns. Directing the same to be left at the
new dwelling house of Mr William Shornburgh of London Merchant
situated on Gresham Hill London. Further that he the said Robert
Ball from and after having got and obtained possession of the
same as aforesaid. And until the end of expiation of the years
next after either of the said parties to these presents his or her
agents or assigns. Shall give notice in writing to the other of them
of his or her desire to Discontinu the Agreement in these
points mentioned and contained shall and will well & lawfully
and diligently to the best of his power. Skill and knowledge apply
him self in the managing. managing. Regulating and
improving the lands & plantations before aforesaid. either
by himself or by the overseers servants or slaves for the time
being. belonging to the lands & plantations aforesaid. In governing
providing for the stock & families horses & servants belonging
in making up land. Shipping off or selling the Merchantable
goods and products thereof. In ridding and getting in the
lands due and owing to the lands & plantations aforesaid. And in
what fittnes taught or Conveyed the said lands & plantations to
most profit and advantage. Item that he the said Robert Ball
shall and will to the intent of the power fully and punctually
so forth as far as he and his body shall see fit do & execute
all the said Catherine Colleton his executors demands or a present
shall from time to time during the continuall of the agreement.

Giv^d and transmitt to him the said Robert Ball touching the
 Misses or any part or p[ar]t of therof, £10m. That he the said
 Robert Ball shall and Will keep on care to keepe true &
 Just accompts in writing of all Receipts, payments & expences
 for and concerning the Lands or plantations aforesaid and of Stock
 land family therof, and also of all the Growthes and productions of
 any by this same, And at the end or expiration of every year
 during the continuall of this agreement shall and will send and
 transmitt to the said Catherine Colleton her Executrix or admittress
 (Directed as aforesaid) True Copies of all the said acco^{ts}, of every
 such year, land and or more Duplicatas therof by favorall
 Conveyances, all signed by him the said Robert Ball, £10m. it
 agreed, And the said Catherine Colleton for her selfe, how-
 ever shee & admittress doth Covenant promiseth to and
 with the said Robert Ball his Executrix and admittress by these
 presents. That she the said Catherine Colleton her Executrix and
 admittress. Shall and will not only allow unto the said Robert Ball
 Competent and sufficiente Meate, Drinke, Washing and Lodging
 During all such time as the said Robert Ball shall be over-
 ridde in or upon any of the lands or Plantations aforesaid
 or shall be busied or employed in Travailing abouty affaires
 and busines thereof, But also shall & Will allow and pay or
 cause to be allowed and paid to the said Robert Ball his ex-
 ecutors, admittress or assignes the summe or value of Sixty
 pounds Sterl. for and in consideration of his Care or paines to
 be taken and used in scheduling the Misses and transmitting
 the same, with Duplicatas therof to London as aforesaid in
 And that from and after the day of such Schedulling or Inventory
 being compleated and signed by the said Robert Ball, She the
 said Catherine Colleton her Executrix or admittress. Shall and Will
 Well and truly allow and pay, or cause to be allowed & paid
 to the said Robert Ball his Executrix, admittress or assignes, the
 summe or value of Sixty pound Sterling per annuall salary
 for each and every year that the said Robert Ball shall live
 and continue in the service or Employment aforesaid, from &
 after his Compleating and signing the Schedule or Inventory
 of the Misses as aforesaid, and PRO RATO for soe long or time
 than alreade, the same to be paid, halfe yearly or oevry 6 months
 by even & equal portions either in England or Carolina,
 the said Robert Ball or his assignes. Shall from time to time
 require the same in witness whereof the said party
 aforesaid to these writings of agreement & covenants have interchang
 a good witten
