Know Y<sup>e</sup> & Whereas Samuel Hartly Merch<sup>t</sup> was admitted y<sup>e</sup> Administration of y<sup>e</sup> Goods & Chattels Rights, Credits of Benjamin Waddy Merch<sup>t</sup> late of this Province Deceased, And Whereas y<sup>e</sup> Administration of y<sup>e</sup> Deceaseds Estate was by y<sup>e</sup> right reverend father in God Thomas by divine Providence Arch Bishop of Canterbury Primate & Metropolitane of all England Granted to Martha Waddy wife of Row Waddy Sister to y<sup>e</sup> said Deceased as by y<sup>e</sup> Letters of Administration for y<sup>e</sup> said Martha Recorded in y<sup>e</sup> Secretarys Office doth appear & Whereas y<sup>e</sup> said Martha Waddy & Edward Waddy her husband have under their hands and Seals, by y<sup>e</sup> Letters of Procuration recorded in y<sup>e</sup> Secretarys Office, fully Impowd y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Hartly to take & Receive all y<sup>e</sup> Goods and Chattels, rights and Credits of y<sup>e</sup> said Deceased at any time of his Decease or at anytime after did belong to y<sup>e</sup> said Benjamin Waddy by virtue of w<sup>ch</sup> Letter of Procuration y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Hartly hath Requested him self of y<sup>e</sup> Goods & Chattels, Rights & Credits of y<sup>e</sup> said Benjamin Waddy, of y<sup>e</sup> said Ordinary (as far as it concernyng said Office) Resaving to Every one his Rights To by these Pres<sup>ts</sup> Discharge y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Hartly from y<sup>e</sup> said Administration & from y<sup>e</sup> Giving or Rendering any further or other Account or Reckoning relating to y<sup>e</sup> same within y<sup>e</sup> aforesaid Part of our Province, Provided y<sup>e</sup> said Samuel Hartly be not convicted of fraud or Deceit. Know all Men by these Pres<sup>ts</sup> y<sup>e</sup> Gabriel Dingells Citizen, Draper & London have made ordayned constituted & appointed by these Presents Do make, Ordayne, constitute & appoint Charles Dingells of Charles Town in South Carolina, Gent<sup>l</sup>, my true & lawfull Attorney for me & in my place & for my Heirs, assigns, demand & receive of Thomas Cary of Charles Town in South Carolina, afores<sup>d</sup>, Merch<sup>t</sup>, all Sum<sup>s</sup> & Sums of Money Goods Effects any way due owing or belonging to me from y<sup>e</sup> Thomas Cary or in his y<sup>e</sup> Thomas Carys hands, And upon Non Paym<sup>t</sup> thereof y<sup>e</sup> Thomas Cary his goods, or Administration for me & in my Name to sue, arrest, Impound, & Prosecute for y<sup>e</sup> same, & upon such suit to proceed to Judgment & Execution & thereupon y<sup>e</sup> Tho. Cary his goods & Administration in Prison to hold & keep until y<sup>e</sup> Paym<sup>t</sup> thereof be made, w<sup>ch</sup> all Costs & Damages suit payned & to be satisfied by occasion of y<sup>e</sup> y<sup>e</sup> same & Upon Payment thereof y<sup>e</sup> Tho. Cary his Executors & Administrators forth of Prison to Discharge & Acquittance for y<sup>e</sup> same or any Part thereof for me & in my Name to Make, Seal & Deliver, And also to do Perform and Execute all & every Other lawfull & reasonable Acts & things to be done both for Obtaining & Discharging of y<sup>e</sup> same, as shall be needfull to be Done, Giving & by these Pres<sup>ts</sup> Granting unto my Attorney my full & absolute Power in y<sup>e</sup> Premises, Ratifying & holding firm all to sever my Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be Done in or about Premises by virtue of these Pres<sup>ts</sup>. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & Seal y<sup>e</sup> seventeenth day of March in y<sup>e</sup> fourth Year of y<sup>e</sup> Reign of our Sovereign Lord William y<sup>e</sup> third by y<sup>e</sup> Grace of God of England, Scotland, France & Ireland King, Defender of y<sup>e</sup> Faith &c. Annoq<sup>ue</sup> Domini 1699.
