by grace of God of England Scotland France & Ireland King Defender of the  
Faith &c<sup>r</sup> Before me James Puckle Notary & Abellion Publick dwelling  
London by Royal Authority Admitted & sworn in the Presence of  
hereafter named Personallly appeared M<sup>r</sup> Samuel Sheppard & M<sup>r</sup> Thomas  
Starke of London Merchants who declared to have made Ordained & Constituted  
by these Pres<sup>t</sup> Dr. Mates Ordain & Constitutes Capt. Thomas Mann Comman<sup>d</sup>er  
of the Edward & Francis & Jonathan Amory of Carolina Merchant jointly  
Severally their true & Lawfull Attorneys giving & by these Pres<sup>t</sup>  
Granting unto their said Attorneys or either of them good lawfull Power  
& Lawfull Authority for them the said Constituents in their Names & to  
their use to ask Demand Levy Sueror & by all Lawfull Meanes a man  
recover & receive of Henry Pittman his Heirs Execut<sup>r</sup> Administrat<sup>r</sup>  
goods Chattels Negre<sup>r</sup> Slaves Effects & Estate whatsoever all am  
every such Fund & Summs of Money goods Wares Merchandizes  
Negro<sup>r</sup> Slaves Gold Elephants Beeth wax Effects & merchandizes in  
the hands Custody or Possession to them the said Constituents due or  
belonging or in any wise appertaining for or upon account of what was  
Saved out of the Ship or Vessel called the Empress of London of the  
Burthen of Poverty Lons or thereabouts whereof the said Henry  
Pittman was late Master as for or upon any other Acc<sup>t</sup> whatsoever  
And to that End with the Heirs Execut<sup>r</sup> or Administrat<sup>r</sup> of the said  
Henry Pittman or all others whom it shall or may concern to  
acc<sup>t</sup> & review settle Adjut<sup>r</sup> all Acc<sup>t</sup> & of ballance thereof to receive  
Upon recoveries & Receipts to give one or more Recquittances or notes  
Sufficient discharges in due form of Law But in case of refusal or  
Delay by the Execut<sup>r</sup> or Administrat<sup>r</sup> of the said Henry Pittman  
any other Person or Persons whom it shall or may concern to make  
paym<sup>r</sup> or satisfaction in the Premises him her or them thereon

to Compell by all Lawfull waies & meanes whatever of if need be to appear  
before all Lordis Judges & Justices in any Court or Courts thereto annexed  
Defend & reply in all matters & causes touching or concerning the Premises  
to do say Pursue Implead Seize Requerer attack Imprison or Condemne  
out of Prison again to Deliver with Power to Substitute one or more  
Attorneys under them with like or Limited Power of same again to render  
Indifferently in & concerning of Premises to Do Performe & execute  
whatsoeuer shall be requisite & necessary as fully simply & effectually  
to all Intents Construction & Purposes as they in Said Constituents might  
or could do personally pres<sup>t</sup> & y<sup>r</sup> although if as should require more  
Special or ample Power than is herein before particularly before you  
say the said Constituents hereby promising to satisfy Confirming  
hold for good & valid all & whatsoever their said Attorneys or  
either of them or their Substitutes shall Lawfully Do or cause  
to be done in or about the Premises by virtue of these Pres<sup>t</sup>
