

I know all men by these presents that I Sarah
Barker of Hertford County in the Province of
Carolina by force & compulsion of certaine power
or letters of Attorney bearing date in Jamaica the
thirtieth day of March Anno domini 1698 by
my husband Thomas Barker late of this Province
have of the Island of Jamaica to me made for &
in consideration of the sum of fifty & one round
pounds five shillings to me in hand paid by Thomas
Cary of the County of Dorsetshire Esq: his receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge & have bargain sold by these
presents unto the said Thomas Cary two negro men by name
Dector and Passenells and one negre woman by name
Cotty to have and to hold the aforesaid negroes with
their issue to him the said Thomas Cary his heirs
and assigns for ever provided always that if my
said husband Thomas Barker his heirs Executors
Administrators or assigns or any of them shall pay
into the said Thomas Cary or his estate after my
decease the full sum of two hundred and
fifty pounds of eight of eight shillings or more
over and above the sum of fifty pounds next or within four
months after the death of the said Thomas Barker & his heirs
at Jamaica aforesaid which shall happen first or that if it
be so that the said Thomas Barker shall not yet have paid
the said sum of two hundred and fifty pounds
then the said Thomas Cary or his assigns
shall pay unto the said Thomas Cary or his assigns
the aforesaid sum of two hundred and fifty pounds
or the like money in ready money or in
Carolina on or before the first day of January
next which in such case the said Barker shall pay
or payed and if none effect in such case the said
hand hereunto set my hand and seal this ninth
and twentieth day of September Anno domini 1698

Charles town in the Province of Carolina have sold and
conveyed unto which smart of the Island of Barbados the sum of
seventy and one round pounds to be paid to the said which smart his
Executors Administrators or assigns to which pay most well and truly
to be made by me the said my heirs Executors Administrators and
assigns firmly by these presents witness my hand and seal at
Charles town this six day of October Anno domini one thousand six
hundred ninety & eight

Whereas Percivell Pawley of Charles town in the Province
of Carolina the second day of August one thousand six hundred
ninety and eight hath drawn his first second and third Bill of Ex
change all of one tenor and date for a sum of sixty round pounds
sterling of Barbados on the said Alexander Parris March these payable to the
said Alexander Parris all twenty days after sight for a value here
of the said Alexander Parris and whereas the said Alexander Parris in
consideration of a value of the said Bill paid him here in good Dollars
all here the sum of six hundred and thirty shillings and four pence
on back of said Bill to pay the contents thereof to the said which smart
or his order now the consideration of the above obligation is such
if one of the said Bill shall not find due acceptance and payment
according to the tenor and effect thereof but shall come back protested
then if the above bound Alexander Parris his heirs Executors Admini
strators or assigns shall pay or cause to be paid to the said which
smart or his assigns the sum of sixty round pounds in current good Dollars
and the sum of six hundred and thirty shillings and four pence for Ex
change and after the rate of six pence the pound more on the charge of protest
and all other incident charges then this obligation to be void and of
none effect else to remain in full force and virtue
