 sell and dispose of as she shall think meet and convenient all
 and every part and parcel of my Estate both real and personal
 that is or heretofore shall be inde appertaininge to me at
 Carolina aforesd together with all my Right Title Interest Estate
 and Demand of me or to the same or any part or parts of y^e same
 And I further Authorised and by these presents impowers her in her
 own Name to Sign Seal and Deliver and the same to be in my
 full force & feare as if I my selfe were present
 to Sign Seal and Deliver and all and all manner of Deeds
 Statutes or Discharges for Money Recovered Deeds of Sale or Dealing
 and other Deeds and writings that shall be required for
 recovering selling making a good fitte Setting Letting and in
 parting all and any part or parcel of my Estate in Carolina
 whereas I will I do further give unto my said Attorney full
