Gibbon Wth of y^e s^d province jointly & separately to be our true & lawful Attorney or Attorneys in y^e province of Carolina in our names to be our use to ask, require, sue for, levy, recover & receive all and all manner of debts, demands, sums & sums of money due or here to be due or payable to us or either of us y^e s^d Charles Squire or Mary his wife Capasitated as afores^d by any person or persons whomsoever of y^e s^d Province of Carolina or there residing for any real or personal estate, goods wares Merchandises accounts or for any other Matter Cause or thing whatsoever giving & granting to our s^d Attorneys jointly & separately full power & lawfull Authority for us & in our names to commence & prosecute any suit or suits Action or actions Real personal or mixt either in Law or Equity, against all & every such person or persons as shall deny & refuse upon demand to pay & satisfy all such debts, due demands, sums or sums of money & to recover in respective acquittances Release or other sufficient discharge for us And in our names to make Oath & deliver And our Attorney or more under them or either of them to make constitute & appoint and att their or either of their pleaders again to receive and farther to do all other things needful for recovering thereof as we our selves might do were we there personally present ratifying & confirming by these p^{rs}ents whatsoever our s^d Attorneys or either of them shall lawfully do in our names concerning y^e premises In witness whereof we y^e s^d Charles Squire & Mary Squire have hereunto putt our hands & seals this 12th day of November in y^e first year of our Sovereign Lady Ann & And in y^e year of our Lord God 1702
