well and truly to be made and done. I binde my self my Heires
Executors and Administrors for the whole and in the whole
firmly by these presents. Sealed with my Seale and Dated the
Two & twentith day of April anno Domini 1695

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above
bounden Thomas Mann his Heires Executors and Administrors or either
of them. Do well and truly pay or cause to be paid to the said
Thomas Cary his Heires Executors Administrors or assigns the full
just summe of eighty pounds lawfull money of England good lawfull
or within seven dayes after Mr John Stoddard of London Gent
making oath before any one of his Majesties Justices of the peace
in London or Westminster, that the said Thomas Cary won from
the said Thomas Mann the aforesaid summe of Eighty pounds a
Play. att the Shipps in Castle Tavern in Cornhill London
time in October last past then this above written obligation
remains in full force and virtue else to be void and of none effect

I now all Men by these Presents that I Samuel Salter of y^e Isle of Bermuda Mariner do Make, Ordain Constitute putt & appoint John Jones of this Province Locksmith my true & Lawfull Attorney for & in my Name Place & Stead to Ask Demand Sue for Recover and receive of & from all & every Person & Persons whatsoever within Power all such Sums of Monies, Goods, Wares, Merchandize, Effects or things whatsoever which may be due, Owning, Owning, Owning, Owning, Owning or belonging to me y^e said Samuel Salter by any manner of wares or means whatsoever or howsoever but More especially if y^e Sloop unity of Bermuda which was lately taken from me y^e said Samuel Salter by y^e said Pirates & Company Pirates should at any time arrive here into any Port or harbor in this Province or any other Loading of Logg wood Sails, Riggings, Anchors, Cables or what also may be due belong or appertain to y^e said at y^e Time y^e said Pirates took y^e said Sloop unity, y^e same or any part thereof y^e said Premises to take into his Possession & further do grant unto my said Attorney my full & whole Power to use all & every waies means in y^e Law whatsoever for y^e Recovery of y^e said Premises & all or any part thereof & my self might or could have or use if I were present. & y^e Person of me y^e said Constituant in any Court or Courts and before any Judge or Magistrates to represent & upon Receipt of y^e Premises or any part thereof in demand or recovery as aforesaid. Receipts or any other sufficient Discharges in y^e Law whatsoever for me & in my Name to make & give & if it shall be Lawfull for my said Attorney to make one or more Attorneys under him with y^e like Limited Power & y^e same at his will & Pleasure again to revoke & make void. All things confirming all what my said Attorney or his substitutes shall Lawfully do or cause to be done in & about y^e Premises or any part thereof. Now the Condition of the Obligation is Such That if the said Daniel Puckle do well & truly Accept & Pay the said Bills of Exchange any or either of them according to y^e Purport true Intent & meaning of y^e same to y^e said Micajah Perry Richard Haynes & Company or Order or if for want of Acceptance or Paym^t of y^e said Bills or any or either of them by the said Daniel Puckle the said Micajah Perry Richard Haynes & Company or Order be forced to Proove the said Bills any or either of them. If then y^e said Thomas Mann his Heirs Executors or Administrators or some of them do well & truly Pay or Cause to be paid to y^e said Micajah Perry Richard Haynes & Company
