Whereas the abovebound John Waylett hath drawn three Bills of Exchange all of one Tenor y^e even & equalle Dated unto these Pres^{ts} for y^e Sum of Fifty Pounds ster. upon Walter Drury Apothecary in Horse Lane London payable to y^e above named William Morgan or Order at Sight. Now the Condition of y^e above Obligation is such, That if y^e Walter Drury do well and truly pay unto y^e William Morgan or Order the said Sum of Fifty Pounds ster. according to y^e import, true Intent & Meaning of the said Bills of Exchange or either of them and do not suffer y^e said Bills of Exchange to be Protested for Want of Acceptance or Paymt. by the said William Morgan or Order according to y^e Tenor thereof but do well and truly comply wth the same: Then y^e said Bills of Exchange or either of them shall appear to be Paid by y^e William Morgan or Order for Want of Acceptance or Paymt. by y^e Walter Drury in manner aforesaid. And if y^e John Waylett his Heires, Execut^r Administrat^r or Assignee well & truly pay or cause to be paid to the said William Morgan his Execut^r Administrat^r or Assignee y^e said Sum of Fifty Pounds ster. and all other incident Charges arising and Causin by the said Protest then this Obligation to be void or

The Condition of y^e Obligation is such, That if the above bound Thomas Mann John Edmundson or either Edmundson Wife of y^e John, do well and truly pay or cause to be Paid to y^e above named Thomas Mann his Execut^r Administrat^r or Assignee the full & just Sum of Six & Twenty Pounds

Lawfull Money of England at y^e Marine or Carolina
Coffee House in Barchin Lane in y^e City of London above
before y^e 25th day of August next Enforcing the Debt
hereof, or if y^e 2^d Sum of Ten & Twenty Pounds be not paid
within y^e Term as is aforesaid, & then y^e 2^d Thomas Hall and
John Edmundson or either of them their or either of their Exors.
Execut^r or Administrat^r do well and truly Pay or cause to be paid
to y^e 2^d Thomas Chann his Execut^r Administrat^r or Assigns in
the 2^d Province y^e Sum of Ten & Twenty Pounds Lawfull
with all Costs & Damages & Twelv^e p Cent for y^e Difference
in y^e 2^d Moneys then this Obligation to be void or else
to Remane in Force.

Prison again when they shall be so Devised as also to Contest in Law in
most ample Manner with Definitive Sentence and as my Agents
