adjudged alio to all Intents, purposes and Constructions  
whatsoever to Inherit and be Inheritable and Inherited  
and to demand, Challenge take, take, retaine, have, and  
Enjoy all or any maner, Lands, Tenements and hereditam.  
goods, Chattels, Debts Estates, and all other Priviledges and  
Imunitie<sup>s</sup> Benefit and advantage in Law or Equity  
Belonging to y<sup>e</sup> Liege people, and Naturall borne Subjects  
of this KINGDOME, and to make his or their resort or  
Pedigree as heire to his or their Ancestors Linall or Col-
