all Intents and purposes and Constructions as if they
and if every of them had been and were born naturall
Subjects within this Kingdom of England And
be it further Enacted Declared and Ordained by y^e Authority
fore^s that they y^e said Thomas F. Leger de Bacolon, Lewis
Pasquereau and others, shall be and are hereby Enabled and
adjudged able to all Intents, purposes and Constructions,
whatsoever to Inherit and be Inheritable and Inherited
and to demand, Challenge take, take, retaine, have, and
Enjoy all or any manner, Lands Tenements and hereditam^{ts}
goods, Chattels, Debts Estates, and all other Privileges and
Immunities Benefitt and advantage in Law or Equity
belonging to y^e Lige people, and Naturall borne Subjects
of this Kingdom, and to make his or their descent or
Pedigree as heire to his or their Ancestors Lineall or Col-
laterall by reason of any Descent remainder reverter
Right or Title Conveyance Legacy or bequest whatsoever
which hath may or shall from henceforth, descend
remain, revert, accrue, or grow due unto them and every
of them as also from henceforth to take have retaine
Keep

Keep and Enjoy all Manner Lands, Tenements and hereditam^{ts}
which he or they may or shall have by way of purchase
or gift of any person or persons whatsoever, As Also
to prosecute, pursue, maintain, avow, justify, defend all
and all manner of Actions, Suits, Causes, and all other things
to doe as lawfully liberally freely & purely as if they the
said Thomas F. Leger de Bacolon, Lewis Pasquereau & others
and every of them had been born of English parents within
this Kingdom of England and as any other person or persons
borne or derived from English parents within this Kingdom may
lawfully in any wise and in all things, and to all Effects shall
be taken to be and shall be Naturall Lige Subjects of this
Kingdom of England any Law, Act, Statute, provisions Customs
Ordinance or other thing whatsoever, has, made, done
promulged, proclaimed or provided to y^e contrary thereof in
