 me, living & by these Pres^{ts} granting unto my Attorney my full
 whole Power in y^e Execution & performance of all & singular y^e Premises
 & either upon Ending or Receipt of any Matter Cause or thing whatsoever
 Release & Acquittances & other Writings for me & in my Name to do
 Make, Seal & Deliver as y^e Case shall require, me or my or more
 under him to Substitute again at Pleasure to revoke and Cancel
 & to Accomplish, Determine & Execute all Matters & things, Devices
 devices whatsoever in or about y^e Premises as by my Attorney shall seem

 & granting unto my Attorney full Power & Authority by these Pres^{ts}
 for me in my Name & to my use, to do, Exercise, use & execute all & every such

 & I am and I fore, & every of them as my Attorney shall think convenient
 & to give or make any one or more Acquittances or Discharges for y^e same
 me Attorney or more for y^e Purposes afores^d to make, & y^e same at Pleasure
 to Revoke & to Compound & agree for & concerning y^e Premises or any of y^e
 as my Attorney shall think fit In Witness whereof I have hereunto
