Witness my hand & Seal this fourth day of July Anno Domini 1695 and six hundred ninety & five.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above bounden William Row his heirs, Executors, Administrators or assigns shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above named William Smith and Thomas Pinckney or either of them their or either of their Executors, Administrators or assigns the summs of Seventy pounds Currant Money of Philadelphia in Pennsylvania, on the first day of August next ensuing the Date hereof at Philadelphia aforesaid, without fraud or further Delay, that then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to be and remaine in full force and virtue.
