said, expended & paid by Thomas Summers of Charles Town
in the Province of Superior the Receipt whereof I do hereby
acknowledge and receipt of every Part thereof do I do hereby
Conferate & Discharge the y^e Thomas Summers his Deputy
and Administrators by these Preests Have Given, Granted, Sold
and Forfeited, and by these Preests Do fully, freely and absolutely give
Grant, Assigne & Sell unto y^e Thomas Summers one Negro Woman
called Marie together with all and singular her Increase To
have & to hold the said Negro Woman and her Increase
to the y^e Thomas Summers his Deputy Administrators & Assignes and
Heirs own proper Goods, Chattels, and to his and their own proper
Use, Benefit & School for ever. **Provided** always
that if y^e William Bay his Deputy Administrators or Assignes
any of them do well and truly say or cause to be paid to y^e Thomas
Summers his Deputy Administrators or Assignes of y^e full sum of
Eighteen Pounds in Spanish Piece of Eight weighing at least
Thirteen Penny weight or Lion Dollars at five Shillings each Dollar
or Piece of Eight, at or before y^e Seventh & Twentieth day of
June next ensuing y^e Date hereof without fraud or falsehood
then these Preests of Sale to be void and of none Effect But
if Default of Payment of y^e sum of Eighteen Pounds in Part
or in all be made by me y^e William Bay my Deputy Administrator
or Assignes on y^e Day & Year aforesaid contrary to y^e Form aforesaid
then I y^e William Bay my Deputy Administrator & Assignes
each of us shall & will Warrant and for ever Defend y^e Negro
Woman unto y^e Thomas Summers his Deputy Administrator
and Assignes by these Preests. **Provided also** that
if y^e Negro Woman do happen to dye & Depart this life before
the y^e Seventh & Twentieth day of June, then y^e William Bay
for himself his Heirs, Deputy Administrators & Assignes doth Covenant
Grant Promise & Agree to & with y^e Thomas Summers his Deputy
Administrator & Assignes well and truly to pay or cause to be paid
to him, them, or some of them the sum of Eighteen Pounds at
least Thirteen Penny weight or Lion Dollars at five Shillings each
Dollar or Piece of Eight. The Which I do hereby certify

June is the day & Year aforesaid.

of Lands, Tenements and Hereditaments in this Kingdom, or any
other of his Majesty's Dominions as freely, peaceably and
entirely as any Subject born in this Kingdom, and that the
said Isaac Mariq by Vertue of y^e Letters Patents is to
Pay Customs & Duties Indisputably Goods & Merchandise only
as Subjects do and ought to do and to Enjoy all Liberties,
Privileges & Franchises of a Subject born in y^e Kingdom
without any Disturbance, Impediment or Molestation
as by y^e Patent Relation being thereunto had, may
more at large appear. Of all which Not being Requisite
of me y^e Notary, I have Granted these Preests to
Isaac Mariq in time & place
Convenient London y^e 26th of April Anno Dom 1682
