

Know all men by these presents that I William Cilly of the County of Carolina in America do hereby certify my letter to one of the Indentured into Emanuel Crolls of the County of Guilford in the full number of forty hundred good & sufficient Merchantable Square and round Irons to be paid & delivered unto the said Emanuel Crolls his heirs & assigns before or after within O' Sullivan's Cross (where the said O' Sullivan now lives, at the most convenient Landing) & promptly at or upon the last day of March next & failing to which payment well & truly to be made & and my self & my heirs & assigns to be bound & firmly by these presents that the penalty of seven shillings & four pence for each hundred of the above Irons to be delivered as aforesaid is upon the last of March 1689 In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal dated this twenty fifth day of December 1688 years
