Be it known unto all men. ~~Wherfore~~ these presents shall shew
that I William Welfby of Carolina planter and true owner
of one fourth part of the good Brigantine called the Dolphin
burthen thirty and eight tuns or thereabouts now riding
in this harbor or road of Charles Towne doo for and in
consideration of the sum of fifty pounds current money
of this place to me in hand paid before ^{the} Enfeoffing and
Delivery of these presents by M^r William Cappers of this
Province Merchant the Receipt whereof I doo hereby
acknowledge and therewith to be fully to be fully contented
paid and satisfied and for divers other good causes and
considerations me herownto moving, Have given
granted alienated Bargained sold assured and confirmed
and by these presents doo fully clearly and absolutely give
grant alien, bargain sold assured and confirmed unto
said William Cappers his heires Executors Adm^r and assigns
all that ^{part} of the aforesaid Brigantine or Vessel called
the Dolphin together wth all and singular (the like propo-
tion) of her masts yards Riggm Sailes boats appurte-
nances and things whatsoever unto her belonging and
appertaining unto the said William Cappers his heires
Ex^rs Adm^r and assigns **To hold (and to hold** the
said fourth part of the said Brigantine Dolphin wth
other the aforesaid promises and appurtenances
unto the said William Cappers his heires Ex^rs Adm^r
and assigns from henceforth unto his or their own
proper use and behoofe to dispose of as of their own
proper goods and chattels freely clearly and absolutely
forever at his or their own will and pleasure
and the said William Welfby his Executors and Adm^r
the said fourth part of the said vessel wth all and
singular (the like proportion of) her masts yards
Riggm sailes boats appurtenances and things
before bargained and sold and mentioned to be sold
unto the said William Cappers his heires Executors
Adm^r and assigns against all people shall and will
warr^{nt} and by these presents defend for and unto
the

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the space and term of time of one whole year and a
Day to be accounted and recovered from the day of the
date of these presents according to the laws and customs
of London for Enemies, pirates Casualties by Sea Restraints
Kings princes and Governours only Excepted *McWilney*
whereof I the said William Willey, have hereto
set my hand and ^{affixed my} Seals this 30th day of March and
Year 1694 and in the sixt yeare of the reign of
their Sovereigns Majties William Mary over Engle
Scotland &c
