

To All People to whom these presents shall come I Elizabeth Porter wife of Edmund Porter of South Carolina
Esq^r send greeting Whereas the said Edmund Porter by his Certain Letter of Attorney bearing Date the
Richmond day of January in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Seven Did
make Ordains nominate constitute and appoint me the said Elizabeth his Lawfull Attorney To Demand
Enter and take into my possession all such real Estate Negroes Goods Chattells unto Profitts or any
other matter or thing which of Right appertained or belonged to him the said Edmund Porter within
the Province or Government of South Carolina by means of the Death of my mother ^{Agnered} or
nephew John Adams or by or for any other right Cause Way or Means whatsoever and on refusal
thereof to give unto me full power and authority to sue for Enter into and take into my care and possession
out of the Hands of Jonathan Drake or any other person or persons in South Carolina all such lands
negroes Goods or Chattells. Giving and thereby Granting unto me the said Elizabeth full power to sue
Arrest Attach Imprison fine and condemn in Order to the Obtaining the Promises aforesaid
and also for him and in his name to make trial and return and one attorney or more under me
to substitute and at pleasure to make the same and Generally to act and do execute and perform
all other acts matters and things which full necessary and convenient to be done Touching the premises
as full and effectually as he the said Edmund Porter might or could do were he personally present
and further the said Constituent Edmund Porter did give and grant unto me full power and
authority to sell convey lease or dispose of all or any Part or Parcel of the said Lands Negroes Goods or
Chattells to any person or persons whatsoever which of Right appertained or Belonging to him the
said Edmund Porter within the Government of South Carolina or in or near the Town of
Newcastle in the Island of Providence assuming and holding firm and effectual all such sales
Bargains alienations and dispositions which I should do or cause to be done therein touching or
concerning the Premises as by the said Letter of Attorney relation bearing thereunto had
I may appear Now Know Ye that I the said Elizabeth by force and authority of the
Letter of Attorney so to me made have made Ordains substituted and by these Presents Do
make Ordains substitute under my place put my friend Samuel Greene of Charles Towne in
South Carolina Merchant my lawfull and sufficient Deputy and substitute for and
in the name of the said Edmund Porter and to his use to demand Enter into
and take into his possession all such real Estate Negroes Goods or Chattells or other
matter or thing which of Right belongs therunto him the said Edmund Porter either in his
own right or the right of me the said Elizabeth within the Province of South Carolina And
on refusal thereof I hereby give unto my said substitute full power and authority to
sue Enter into and take into his care and possession out of the Hands and possession
of Colonel Jonathan Drake or any other person or persons whatsoever in South
Carolina all such Lands Negroes Goods and Chattells so belonging to the said Edmund
Porter on his own right or in right of me the said Elizabeth his wife to arrest
attach prosecute condemn and imprison any person or persons in possession of
the Lands Tenements Goods or Chattells of the said Edmund Porter and in his
name upon receipt or recovery of all or any the said promises acquittances release or
other discharge to make trial and return And I do also hereby further give unto
my said substitute full power and authority upon recovery or obtaining any of
the said Lands and Tenements Negroes Goods or Chattells to sell convey lease
or otherwise to dispose of all or any the said Lands Negroes Goods or Chattells

to any person or persons whatsoever which of Right belongs or appertains to him
 the said Edmund Porter within the Government of South Carolina or in or near the town
 of Nassau in New Providence allowing and holding firm and effectual all such sales
 bargains alterations or disposals as my said Substitute shall make Do or Cause to
 be made and Done touching or concerning the premises and the said Elizabeth
 Porter by virtue of the said Letter of Attorney to me made Do Give and
 Grant unto the said Daniel Grune full power and authority to Do all
 and every Act and Acts Thing and Things whatsoever meetfull to be
 Done in and about the premises in as ample manner and form as if
 the said Elizabeth Porter might and were I Personally present And I the
 said Elizabeth do hereby further Impower Authorize and Appoint my said
 Substitute to Compound and Agree with any Person or Persons whatsoever
 in possession of the Negroes Goods or Chattells of the said Edmund Porter as aforesaid
 and to accept and take in Lien and full satisfaction of the whole or part hereof
 of and upon Rec^d. of such part to Acquitt and Absolutely to Discharge the said
 Person or persons from whom the same shall be received of and from the whole And
 further to Enter into any Bond or Bonds of Arbitration And to submit the Matters
 in Difference between such person or persons and the said Edmund Porter to the
 said present final And said Determination of Arbitrators to be elected and chosen by my
 said Substitute Daniel Grune And the said persons so in possession of the said
 Negroes Goods or Chattells. And I do hereby Ratify and Allow all and whatsoever my
 said Substitute (for and in the name of the said Edmund Porter) shall lawfully Do or
 Cause to be done in or about the Premises or any of them by these Presents
 In Witness whereof I have hereunto Set my Hand and Seal this Eighteenth Day of
 July Anno Domini 1728.) Eliz. Porter
