 true and Lawfull Attorney Giving and Granting and by these
 presents Granting unto my said Attorney Joseph Wragg in
 case of the death or absence of the s^d William Blumyer full
 power Strength and Authority for me and in my name and
 to my use to Ask Demand Require and Receive of and from
 all and all manner of Persons in the Province aforesaid
 whom it doth or may Concern all Sum & Sums of money debts
 dues debts effects goods wares Merchandise & Things of
 to me the Constituent belonging or to belong due or payable whether
 by Bill Book Bond Specialty, or account or by any other voice
 or means it shall and if need be for if promise or any part thereof to
 sue Implead & prosecute any person or persons whom it doth or may
 Concern and to proceed to Judgment & Execution for or by reason of the
 same and upon recovery or Receipt of any sum or Sums of money or
 Promises aforesaid Acquittances or other Lawfull Discharge for me
 and in my name to make Seal & Deliver, and one or more
 Attorneys in all or any the premises, and for the recovery thereof to
 make Substitute and appoint under him and the same at pleasure
 again to revoke hereby Promising to Ratify and Confirm for
 good Valid & Effectual all & Wth my said Attorney
 Joseph Wragg or his Substitutes shall, in the death or
 absence of the s^d William Blumyer Lawfully do or cause
 to be Done by Virtue of these Presents In Witness Whereof I
 the s^d Henry Wiggington have hereunto Set my hand
 and Seal this nine & Twentieth^{day} of April in the Year of Our Lord
