 Allen of the Town and Province aforesd mealt to be my true sufficient and
 Lawfull Attorneys for me and in my name and Stead and to inquire
 to ask Demand, Levy Require, Receive and Receive; of and from all and
 Every Person & Persons whomsoever the Same shall and may concern,
 all and singular Sums & Sums of money, Debts, Goods, Wares Merchandise
 Effects & Things Whatsoever & Wheresoever they shall and may be found due
 owing, payable, belonquing and coming unto me the Constituent by any
 ways and means Whatsoever nothing Excepted or Reserved; Giving and
 hereby Granting unto my Said Attorneys my full and whole
 straight Power and Authority in and about my Premises; and to Sale
 and use all due means Course and Process in the Law for the
 Obtaining and Recovering the Same, & of revenues & receipts thereof,
 In my name to make Seal & Execute due acquittances, and Discharges
 and for the Premises to Appear, and the Power of me the Constituent to
 represent before any Governor Judges Justices, Officers & Ministers of
 the Law, or before any Court or Courts Judicative, and thereon my,
 behalf to Answer, Defend and Reply unto all Actions, Causes, Matters
 and Things whatsoever relating to the premises, with full power to make
 and substitute one or more Attorneys under my said Attorneys and the
 same again at Pleasure to revoke, and Generally to say, do act
 Transact Determine, Accomplish & Finish, all matters and Things
 whatsoever, relating to the Premises, as fully amply Effectually, to all
 Intents & Purposes, as if the Said Constituent ought or might
 personally, as that the matter should require more Special
 Authority then is herein comprised & The Said Constituent
 Ratifying allowing and holding firm and Tied all and
 whatsoever my said Attorneys or their Substitutes shall
 Lawfully do or cause to be done In and about the premises
