called the Margaritta of London of the Burthen of One hundred
and twenty or thereabouts more being in the River Thames
and wherof Joseph Palmer was Late Master and also all and
Every the Anchors Cables Ropes Boards Guns Ammunition
Provisions Necessaries Appurtenances and Things whatsoever
to the said Vessel belonging in anywise appertaining to have
and to hold the said Bargained Promises & Every part thereof unto
the said Peter Hambley his Executors Adminors & Assigns & who
and their own use & uses and as his and their own goods and
Chattells from hence forth fully and absolutely for Ever and the
said John Stevenson do hereby for my self my Executors and
Adminors Herment and Agree to and with the said Peter Hambley
his Executors Adminors and Assigns by These presents that I the
said John Stevenson have in my self good Right full power and
Lawfull Authority to Grant Bargain and Sell the said
Bargained Promises & Every part thereof unto the said Peter
Hambley his Executors Adminors and Assigns in manner
as aforesaid and that the said Bargained Promises and Every
