 Attorney for me and in my name and for my use to Ask
 Demand, Sue for Recey. Receive and Receive all such Sum and
 Sum of money Debts, Goods, Wares, Rents, Accounts and other
 Remances whatsoever which are or shall be due owing payable
 and belonging to me, or Retained from me any manner of way
 or means whatsoever Either in my own right or as Executor or
 Administrator of my late Husband Deceased or as Guardian to any
 of my Children by any person or Person whomsoever within the
 Province of South Carolina Having and Granting to my said Attorney
 by these Presents my full and whole Power Straight and Authority
 in and about the Premises to do or Let and Sale all Lawfull
 Ways and means, in my name for the Recovering thereof and
 upon the Receipt of any such Debts or Sum of money
 aforesaid Acquittance or other sufficient Discharge for me and in
 my name to make Seal & Deliver and Generally all and Every
 other Act and Acta thing and things Drive and Devices in the
 Law — Whatsoever needfull and Necessary to be done in and
 about the Premises for the Recovering of all or any such Debts or Sums
 of money aforesaid for me and in my name, to do, Execute and
 Perform, as full Largely and Ample to all Intent and Purposes, as
 I myself might or could do if I was personally present, or as if
 the matter Required more speciall Authority then as Person Given
 and Attorneys one or more could. Him for the purpose aforesaid to make
 and constitute and Again at Pleasure to Revoke Ratifying Allowing
 and Holding for firm and Effectuall all and whatsoever my said Attorney
 shall Lawfully do in and about the Premises by Virtue hereof In
 Witness Whereof I have hereunto Set my hand & Seal this fiftteenth
 day of July being the fift year of his Majesty King Charles the first
