

Know all men by these Presents that I Peter Hambly of London merchant sole owner or Proprietor of the good Ship or Vessel now called the Green Pinnace formerly the Margarita Kingman as certain part harbour or River in South Carolina or where soever the said Ship shall be found do make ordain constitute and appoint Samuel Green of Carolina aforesaid merchant William Hambly now on board said Ship and Ralph Taylor Commander of the Ship Neptune my true & lawful Attorneys for me and in my name and for my use to Enter into and Take Possession of the said Ship or Vessel and to Replace and Discharge John Stephenson att. Stevedore his place of master or Command: of the same and further to Sue prosecute Impound and Imperson him of^d said John Stephenson for all such sum and sums of money as he shall owe or be indebted unto me upon any demand whatsoever (in case of his Refusal to pay the same upon demand) to my said Attorneys for my use and further Impowering my said Attorneys to call him of said John Stephenson to an account for all misdemeanours Maimanigments Doubrillments Loss damage & Detriment whatsoever made committed and suffered by him or his orders to the prejudices of the said Ship or her voyage to me as owner thereof and further Impowering my S^d Attorneys to demand and recover of the said John Stephenson all Balances of account and all other accounts relating to the said Ship or voyage and finally to do all and Every other matters and Things for me and my name and for my use both for Prosecuting and Discharging him the S^d John Stephenson as I myself might or could do if I personally present do do. if I do further by these Presents constitute nominate & appoint the said Will^m Hambly to be master or Command: of the said Ship or Vessel and to navigate the same to y^e port of London and to do all & Every other matters & Things which to a master shall Appertain In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & Seal this 24th day of February 1717.
