God for the same do make & ordain this my Last Will and
Testament in manner and form following that is to say,
Inprimis I give my Soul into the hands of Almighty God hoping
through the meritts of my Saviour Jesus Christ forgiveness of
all my sins and my body I bequeth to the Earth to be
decently buried at the Discretion of my Executor hereafter
named and of my worldly Goods I Dispose as follows
(my just debts and funerals Charges being first Paid
and Satisfied) First I Give devise and bequeth unto my
Loving friend George Tooke Late of London Gent.
all that my Schooner named George now Lying at
an anchor in the Harbour of Charles Town together
with all her mast yards Sails Anchors Cables
Rigging and Appurtenances whatsoever thereunto
belonging to the only use and behoof of him the said
George Tooke his heirs and assigns for Ever. Stern.
I Give and bequeth all the rest and Residue of my
Estate both Real & Personall wheresoever the same is
to be paid unto my dearly beloved Wife Elizabeth
Fry, and to my Son Thomas Fry equally to be
divided between them Share and Share alike, and my will
is that all such Part of my Estate whether Real or
Personall that shall be allotted for my said Son
Thomas when a dividend thereof is made shall
be used and Employed by my said Wife in and for
his maintenance and Education untill he attain his age
of Twenty one years, And in case my said wife Elizabeth
shall happen to dye before my said Son Thomas, then
I give and bequeth all such Part of my Estate as is
herein before to her devised unto my said Son Thomas to
the use of him and his heirs forever, and in case my
said Son Thomas shall happen to dye before he attain
his age of Twenty one years and without Issue then
I give and bequeth all that Part of my Estate herein
before to him devised unto my said Wife Elizabeth to
the use of her and her heirs for Ever And in case they shall
both happen to dye before the times herein before mentioned
and Expresses then I give and bequeth all the said residue
of my Estate herein before devised unto the said Elizabeth

and Thomas to my Beloved Brother and Sister William and Martha
 my Equally to be divided between them Share and Share alike to the use
 of them the said William and Martha and their Heirs for Ever, and
 further will is that my said Loving friend George Footes
 shall Sell and Dispose of my Cargo now on board
 the said Schooner George according to his Discretion and that
 and that he remitt the most proceeds thereof unto my said
 wife Elizabeth now residing in the City of Bristol and my
 Will is that when and after my debts Legacies and
 Funerall Charges are paid and discharged that with all
 convenient speed an Exact dividend of my Estate be made,
 And Lastly I do hereby Constitute and Appoint my Loving friend
 George Footes ^{Execr} of this my Last Will and Testament hereby
 revoking and disannulling all former Wills by me made, In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this Twelfth day
 of August in the fifth year of his Majesties King Anno Dom: 1718.
