John Masters Com<sup>d</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Kingston Slope who being also duly sworn did declare that he was very well acquainted with the handwriting of M<sup>r</sup> Jasper Ashworth and doe believe the within letter to be written and subscribed by him and further saith not.
